



## MATCH STORYLINES

### Past Regular Season Match

Inter Miami will eye consecutive wins on the road after defeating CF Montréal 1-4 on Saturday at Stade Saputo in Montreal, Quebec, Canada.

Captain Lionel Messi delivered a standout performance with two goals and an assist, becoming the third player in MLS history to notch at least two goals and one assist in three consecutive league matches, and the first since Thierry Henry in 2012. Attacker Tadeo Allende and midfielder Telasco Segovia notched the team's other goals on the night.

### MLS Player of the Matchday and Team of the Matchday Honors

Messi's standout performance against CF Montréal earned him Major League Soccer (MLS) Player of the Matchday presented by Michelob Ultra honors for Matchday 22. On top of becoming just the third player in MLS history with at least two goals and one assist in three consecutive league matches, the Argentine legend has now recorded nine games with at least three goal contributions since entering the league on August 26, 2023, two more than the next-closest player over the span (Denis Bouanga, seven).

The honor is Messi's third this season and ninth MLS Player of the Matchday presented by Michelob Ultra award in his career. Messi is the 11th player in league history to have won the award at least nine different times and only the second active one to do so (Josef Martínez, nine).

Additionally, Messi, as well as fellow goalscorer Allende and goalkeeper Óscar Ustari earned MLS Team of the Matchday Honors for Matchday 22.

### Firing Attack

Inter Miami's attacking unit has been in fine form so far in 2025, with forwards/wingers/attacking midfielders accounting for 34 of the team's 40 goals thus far this MLS regular season. Messi leads the way in goals with 12, while also currently being tied for third in MLS with 19 goal contributions (12 goals, seven assists) and leads the league in goals per game (0.86). Allende, who's struck five times in his past six regular season appearances, comes next with seven goals, while Segovia and Luis Suárez follow with four goals a piece. Fafa Picault and Allen Obando round out the list with four goals and a strike respectively.

### Previsously Against the New England Revolution CF Montréal

Wednesday's meeting presents the ninth matchup against the Revs in Club history. So far, Inter Miami leads the series with five wins to three for New England. Last year, Inter Miami claimed dominant wins in both regular season fixtures between the teams, first winning 1-4 on the road in April, before coming out on top 6-2 at Chase Stadium in October on MLS Decision Day.

### Scouting the New England Revolution

New England Revolution will host Inter Miami after falling 2-1 on the road against the Portland Timbers on Saturday. In all, the Massachusetts-based side has recorded six wins, seven losses and six draws for a total 24 points and sits 11th in the Eastern Conference standings. Spanish midfielder Carles Gil has been the leader for the Revs this regular season with seven goals and seven assists.

From competing at an unprecedented international level in 2025 to moving into a new, state-of-the-art stadium in Miami in 2026, this is more than just a change of scenery; it's the beginning of a thrilling new era for the Club. ### 2024 Success

The 2024 MLS regular season was the best one yet for the Club. Inter Miami achieved a record-breaking campaign in which the Club recorded historic stats, orchestrating an impressive turnaround for the team, going from 27th in the Supporters' Shield race in 2023 to first in 2024.

The notable achievements for the side that was managed by head coach Gerardo 'Tata' Martino include setting a new single-season points record in the league with 74 points, registering the best overall 2024 MLS regular season record (22W-4L-8D) to win the Supporters' Shield and clinch a second title in Club history, becoming the third-fastest club in league history to earn a playoffs berth and secure a third-ever postseason appearance for the Club, recording the most overall wins (22) and wins on the road (11), and leading the league in goals with 83.

## 2025 MLS Player of the Matchday Honorees:

**Matchday 16:** Forward Lionel Messi: The reigning Landon Donovan MVP scored a brace with two fantastic strikes and dished out an assist to lead Inter Miami to a 4-2 win at home over CF Montréal on Wednesday. The attacker delivered an all-around top performance, finishing the night with a notable three key passes and seven shots to his name, both game highs. The recognition is Messi's first Player of the Matchday award and the first for an Inter Miami player this 2025 regular season. Last year, Messi earned a record-tying six Player of the Matchday awards, becoming the third player in league history to do so during his first full season with Inter Miami.

**Matchday 17:** Forward Lionel Messi: Messi earned POTM honors for a second consecutive matchday following his brilliance on the pitch, notching two goals and three assists in a dominant 5-1 home win for Inter Miami over Columbus. Overall it was a well rounded performance from Messi as he led the Herons to victory, registering an 87 percent pass completion rate and two shots on target. Messi became the first player to win back-to-back Player of the Matchday awards this season and second to win twice in 2025, joining Philadelphia Union forward Tai Baribo.

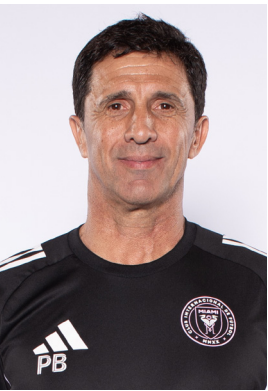

Prior to joining Inter Miami, Messi also spent two seasons with French powerhouse Paris Saint-Germain FC (2021-2023), where he made 75 appearances across all competitions, and tallied up 32 goals
- Holds several records across different competitions like: the most goals scored in a calendar year (91 goals), most goals in Europe's top five leagues (496 goals), most LaLiga goals (474 goals), most LaLiga goals in a single season (50 goals), most UEFA Champions League group stage goals (80 goals), most UEFA Champions League round of 16 goals (29 goals), and most successive seasons scoring in UEFA Champions League (18).
- At the international level, Messi has made history in Argentina, holding the most caps with 175, the most goals with 103, and the most World Cup match appearances with 26. The versatile playmaker has also become the only player to score in the World Cup group stage, round of 16, quarterfinals, semifinals and final.
- Messi has lifted dozens of team trophies so far, winning the UEFA Champions League four times, an Olympic gold medal, three FIFA Club World Cups, 10 LaLiga titles, two Ligue 1 titles, seven Copa del Rey titles, one Trophée de Champions as well as the 2021 CONMEBOL Copa América title, the 2022 CONMEBOL-UEFA Cup of Champions, and the 2022 FIFA World Cup title.
- So far through out his career, Messi has earned eight Ballon d'Or titles, three Best FIFA Men's Player awards, two FIFA World Cup Golden Balls, three UEFA Men's Player of the Year Awards, six European Golden Shoes, six LaLiga Best Player recognitions, eight Pichichi Trophies and 15 Argentine Footballer of the Year awards.
