CLUB CAREER OUTSIDE MLS: Made more than 180 appearances across all competitions in eight-year professional career in England and Spain...Totalled 13 goals and 14 assists in European career...Began career with hometown club Valencia CF in 2012 after developing in the club's academy system from age five...Loaned to Elche CF of Spain ahead of the 2012-13 campaign, where he helped the club earn a promotion to La Liga for the first time in 25 years...Scored five goals in 64 appearances for Elche across two seasons...Recalled to Valencia CF ahead of 2014-15 campaign, scoring one goal in 11 appearances with the top-flight club in 452 minutes of action...Signed with English Premier League side Aston Villa in the January transfer window during the 2014-15 season, totaling three goals and three assists in 34 total appearances in his time with the English club...Spent parts of three seasons with Deportivo de La Coruña between La Liga and the Segunda División, amassing one goal and seven assists in 54 total appearances with the Galician club.
