YUEILL AT A GLANCE

- Owns 224 MLS appearances, including 201 games started, and 17,954 minutes played across nine MLS seasons with San Jose (2017-2024) and New England.
- Selected sixth overall by San Jose in the 2017 MLS SuperDraft as a Generation adidas product.
- Spent parts of two seasons on loan with Earthquakes' USL affiliate, Reno 1868 FC, making professional debut in 2017.
- Owns 16 senior caps for the United States Men's National Team, along with 27 youth caps at the U-18, U-20, and U-23 levels.
- A two-year standout at UCLA, started 34 of 40 collegiate appearances and tallied nine goals and 17 assists in over 3,000 minutes, earning two First Team All-PAC-12 selections.

HOW ACQUIRED: Signed as a free agent to a three-year contract through the 2027 MLS season, with club options for 2028 and 2029, on Dec. 18, 2024.



MLS CAREER: Selected by the San Jose Earthquakes in the first round (sixth overall) of the 2017 MLS SuperDraft... Career regular season totals include 224 appearances, 201 starts, 13 goals, and 19 assists across 17,954 minutes played...Also owns three postseason appearances, including two starts...In first season with New England in 2025, started eight of 14 MLS appearances, along with two additional starts in the U.S. Open Cup...In 2024, matched career high with 32 appearances, including 28 starts, with one goal and two assists...Added one goal in four starts during Leagues Cup 2024, along with two additional U.S. Open Cup appearances...Logged 31 appearances, all starts, in 2023, scoring one goal, and matched career high with five assists...Started and played 90 minutes in lone postseason match...Played in two games during Leagues Cup 2023, and one additional start in the U.S. Open Cup...Notched career-high four goals, with two assists, over 31 appearances, all starts, during the 2022 campaign...Made two U.S. Open Cup appearances...Started 28 of his 29 appearances in the 2021 regular season, tallying three goals...In 2020, started all 21 regular season appearances, tallying one goal and one assist...Added two appearances in the MLS is Back Tournament Knockout Stage...Started and played 120 minutes in lone postseason match...Made 32 appearances, with 29 starts, during the 2019 season, tallying three goals and five assists...Added one start in the U.S. Open Cup...Logged 21 appearances, starting 15 times, recording three assists in 2018...Made one U.S. Open Cup appearance, along with one USL appearance for affiliate club Reno 1868...In first MLS season, made 13 appearances with 10 starts in regular season play, recording one assist...Added one goal and one assist in four U.S. Open Cup appearances...Suited up six times for USL affiliate Reno 1868 FC...Made MLS Cup Playoffs debut with substitute appearance.

2017 (WITH SAN JOSE): In first MLS season, made 13 appearances with 10 starts in regular season play, recording one assist...Added one goal and one assist in four U.S. Open Cup appearances...Suited up six times for USL affiliate Reno 1868 FC...Logged professional debut for Reno on March 25...(6/14) vs. SFD: Made Earthquakes debut in U.S. Open Cup action, scoring first professional goal, a game winner, in a 90-minute effort...(6/17) vs. SKC: Made MLS debut...(6/28) vs. SEA: Notched first professional assist, a game-winning helper, in the U.S. Open Cup Round of 16...(8/27) at LA: Recorded first MLS assist...**Postseason:** Made MLS Cup Playoffs debut with substitute appearance...(10/25) at VAN: Appeared off the bench for postseason debut, logging four minutes.

INTERNATIONAL (UNITED STATES): Owns 16 senior caps for the United States Men's National Team...Made senior international debut on June 6, 2019, starting and playing 59 minutes in a friendly against Jamaica...On the roster for both the 2021 and 2023 Concacaf Gold Cup tournaments...Also made a combined 27 youth caps at the U-18, U-20, and U-23 levels...Captained U-23 side during Olympic Qualifying in 2021, scoring two goals...Scored one goal in 13 appearances with the U.S. U-18 squad.

COLLEGE (UCLA): A two-year standout at UCLA, started 34 of 40 collegiate appearances and tallied nine goals and 17 assists in over 3,000 minutes for the Bruins...Earned two selections to the All-PAC-12 First Team...Helped Bruins reach consecutive NCAA Tournaments...In sophomore season, started 16 of 20 appearances, tallying two goals and a conference-best 11 assists...As a freshman in 2015, started 18 of 20 games, scoring seven goals and adding six assists...Finished 12th among all NCAA freshman in scoring.
