- Among MLS leaders in regular season minutes (29,294), appearances (344), and starts (328), since entering league as the first-overall SuperDraft pick in 2013.
- The Revolution's all-time leader in MLS appearances, starts, and minutes, and the club's only player to appear in over 300 MLS matches.
- 14th-year defender is the longest-tenured active athlete in Boston professional sports.
- Voted the club's Defender of the Year five times by local media (2015, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022).
- Owns 15 appearances, all starts, and 1,433 minutes played in the MLS Cup Playoffs.

**HOW ACQUIRED:** Selected by the Revolution with the first-overall pick in the 2013 MLS SuperDraft...Since 2025, has served in a dual Player Professional Development role, which also sees him coach with the Revolution Academy.
