New England Revolution and Special Olympics Massachusetts Kick off 11th Season of Unified Soccer with Annual Signing Day

19 Special Olympics Massachusetts athletes and Unified Sports® partners will meet with Revolution leadership and sign 2025 contracts at Gillette Stadium on Wednesday afternoon

The New England Revolution, in partnership with Special Olympics Massachusetts and the Arbella Insurance Group, will launch the 11th season of the Revolution Unified Soccer Team with the 19-player squad's annual **Signing Day** at Gillette Stadium on **Wednesday, May 14th beginning at 2:30 p.m. ET**. Media access begins at 2:15 p.m. via the **E3 stadium entrance**.

The 2025 New England Revolution Unified Team will field 19 players, a combination of Special Olympics athletes and local Unified Sports® partners from throughout Massachusetts. The players will be welcomed to the team by Revolution Head Coach **Caleb Porter** in the team's locker room at Gillette Stadium, where they will receive their personalized Revolution kits. The team will then head to the Sports Illustrated Pavilion, where they will be welcomed to the Revolution by President **Brian Bilello**, Sporting Director **Curt Onalfo**, and Arbella Insurance Group Marketing Specialist **Kristen Robinson**. The athletes will then officially ink their contracts for the upcoming two-game season, before donning their uniforms for a photo shoot.

This year, the Revolution Unified team can be seen in action at Gillette Stadium following the club's home game on Saturday, **June 28 vs. Colorado Rapids (7:30 p.m. ET)**, when they will take on the visiting Unified squad. New England continues the season with a road contest against the **Charlotte FC Unified Team**, after the conclusion of Charlotte's MLS match on **Thursday, July 12 (7:30 p.m. ET)** at Bank of America Stadium.

The New England Revolution and Special Olympics Massachusetts will collaborate again in the summer, hosting its fan-favorite annual event, **Bowl for a Goal presented by Arbella Insurance**, on **Wednesday, July 30**. The entire Revolution roster will team up with fans and Special Olympics athletes for an evening of bowling and entertainment at **Splitsville Luxury Lanes at Patriot Place**. In previous years, Bowl for a Goal has raised over \$600,000 for Special Olympics Massachusetts, including \$100,000 raised in 2024 alone.

The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Currently entering the team's 30th season, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. The Revolution also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles. The Revolution play their home matches at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. and are currently coached by two-time MLS Cup winner Caleb Porter. The club and its acclaimed pro pathway, including Revolution II (MLS NEXT Pro) and the Revolution Academy, are headquartered at the Revolution Training Center, which opened ahead of the 2020 season.
