New England Revolution, Special Olympics Massachusetts, and Arbella Insurance Announce 2025 Unified Soccer Team on Signing Day

New England fields 19 Special Olympics Massachusetts athletes and Unified Sports® partners to kick off the 11th season of the Revolution Unified soccer team

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. (May 14, 2025) – The New England Revolution and Special Olympics Massachusetts, in partnership with Arbella Insurance, welcomed Special Olympics Massachusetts athletes and Unified partners to the 2025 New England Revolution Unified Team today at Gillette Stadium. This year's Unified roster features 19 athletes and partners, matching last year's record of the largest team in the program's 11-year history.

The 19 members of the 2025 Revolution Unified Team, all New England natives, were first greeted by New England Revolution Head Coach **Caleb Porter** in the club's locker room at Gillette Stadium to receive their official Revolution uniforms. The team then headed to the Sports Illustrated Pavilion, where they signed their official contracts and received a warm welcome from Revolution President **Brian Bilello**, Sporting Director **Curt Onalfo**, Arbella Insurance Group Marketing Specialist **Kristen Robinson**, and Unified Team Head Coach **Deb Godbout**. Additionally, Revolution players **Tanner Beason**, **Andrew Farrell** and **Wyatt Omsberg** all attended today's event to help welcome the team, while Revolution Public Address Announcer **Mike 'Sarge' Riley** emceed the event.

On **Wednesday, July 30th**, from **6:00-9:00 p.m. ET**, the Revolution Unified Team and the entire 2025 Revolution team will convene at Splitsville Luxury Lanes at Patriot Place for **Bowl for a Goal Presented by Arbella Insurance**. The club's fan-favorite annual fundraiser features an evening of bowling and entertainment alongside Revolution players and Unified Athletes, with all proceeds benefiting Special Olympics Massachusetts. The night also features live music, entertainment from DJ Chris Roxx, a silent auction, raffle, free giveaways, and a chance to meet the entire 2025 Revolution team. Bowl for a Goal has raised over \$600,000 for Special Olympics to date, including \$100,000 raised in 2024 alone. The Revolution Unified Team's mission is to leverage the power of sports to promote an environment

The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Currently entering the team's 30th season, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. The Revolution also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles.
