Revolution Head West to Meet LA Galaxy on Saturday Night

New England targets third straight road win

CARSON, Calif. (September 4, 2026) – The New England Revolution (11-7-4, 37 pts.) continue their four-game road trip on Saturday night with a cross-country visit to Western Conference side LA Galaxy (6-9-8, 26 pts.) at Dignity Health Sports Park. Kickoff is set for 9:30 p.m. ET with live coverage on [Apple TV](#) in English and Spanish. Listen to the Revolution's local radio calls on 98.5 The Sports Hub (English) and 1260 AM Nossa Radio USA (Portuguese).

The Revolution enter the weekend in strong form both at home and on the road, unbeaten in their last three matches and winners of back-to-back road contests by a combined 6-1 scoreline. New England boasts a 2-1-1 record over its last four away matches, which is tied for the third-best road form in MLS during that stretch. Per American Soccer Analysis, the Revolution pace the league in expected goals (17.36) since MLS resumed the season following the FIFA World Cup break.

Most recently, New England secured a come-from-behind 3-1 victory over the Columbus Crew last Sunday, powered by a stellar performance from captain **Carles Gil**, who recorded one goal and two assists. The outing matched Gil's MLS career high for goal contributions in a single match, as he became just the 20th player in league history to reach 150 regular-season goal contributions. **Matt Polster** and **Dor Torgeman** also found the scoresheet in Columbus, with the latter extending his scoring streak to two consecutive matches. The Israeli striker eyes his 25th league start on Saturday and ranks fourth in MLS in expected goals (4.04) since play resumed in July.

English winger **Jack Harrison** continues to etch his name into the record books since joining the Revolution in late July. Harrison has tallied assists in four consecutive starts, one shy of the club record for consecutive league matches with an assist (5), currently shared by Steve Ralston and Gil. With a helper this weekend, Harrison would become the third player in MLS history to log an assist in his first five starts of a season and the first to do so since 1999. Fellow attacker **Diego Fagundez**, a 2024 MLS Cup champion with LA, will face his former club for the first time on Saturday, sitting one goal contribution shy of 100 for the Revolution in regular season action.

New England continued adding reinforcements right up to Wednesday night's transfer deadline, bringing in veteran midfielder **Dániel Gazdag**. The Hungarian international, who is the leading scorer in Philadelphia Union history, eyes his Revolution debut on Saturday. Also on the front line, Homegrown Player **Peyton Miller** continues to provide a spark on the wing with an assist in three straight games, and goal contributions in five of his last seven outings. The Connecticut native leads the team with 22 shots on goal this season and matched his career-high four attempts on frame at Columbus.

Defensively, **Mamadou Fofana** earned MLS Team of the Matchday honors for the fourth time this season after recording his second helper of the campaign on Sunday. Defender **Will Sands**, who has started a career-high 22 matches this season, is poised to make his 50th MLS start on Saturday. Fellow fullback **Ilay Feingold**, an Israel international, aims to suit up for his second straight appearance after returning from a four-month injury absence last weekend.

Saturday's clash renews a historic interconference rivalry between two original clubs. New England and LA Galaxy previously met in three MLS Cup finals (2002, 2005, 2014). LA owns a 20-17-7 advantage in the all-time regular-season series, dating back to 1996. Led by Head Coach Greg Vanney, the Galaxy currently sit 13th in the Western Conference with a 6-9-8 record and a 3-4-4 mark at home. Mexican forward Hirving "Chucky" Lozano scored the club's lone goal in a 3-1 defeat to San Diego FC last weekend, while German midfielder Marco Reus leads the Galaxy with 11 goal contributions (4g, 7a) and ranks fifth in MLS with 53 chances created.

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About the New England Revolution

The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Through 30 MLS seasons, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. New England also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles. The Revolution play their home matches at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. The club and its

acclaimed pro pathway, including Revolution II (MLS NEXT Pro) and the Revolution Academy, are headquartered at the Revolution Training Center, which opened ahead of the 2020 season.

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
