PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

Martinez joins Philadelphia from Uruguay's topflight, Liga AUF Uruguay, after playing a key role in CA Juventud's historic 2024–25 season. He made 12 appearances during the Clausura, helping the club record five clean sheets, and was instrumental in Juventud's successful promotion run through the Segunda División Playoffs. Earlier in the season, Martinez was on loan with Central Español FC, where he contributed to the club's first promotion since 2012. Across the 2024 and 2025 seasons, he helped two different clubs earn promotion to the Primera División and most recently played a part in Juventud's historic qualification for the 2026 Copa Libertadores.

PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

Lukic signed a four-year contract with FK Spartak Subotica of the Serbian Super League, Serbia's top tier, in September 2023. He recorded two goals in 39 total appearances in two seasons (2023-24) and ranked tied for 3rd on the team with two goals during the 2023-24 campaign. In January 2023, Lukic signed a long-term contract with LASK of Austria's Bundesliga, Austria's top tier league, before being loaned to SC Uniao Torreense of Portugal's second league. He appeared in 17 matches for Torreense in two seasons (2022-24), including two games in the 2023 Allianz Cup. Lukic began his career with FK Cukaricki of Serbia's Super League for four seasons (2019-23), including Cukaricki's U19 squad (2019-21). He collected three goals and three assists in 71 total appearances with FK Cukaricki and three goals and one assist in 26 total matches with Cukaricki U19. Lukic set a career high and ranked T-4th on FK Cukaricki during the 2021-22 season with 34 appearances. He was one of four players to appear in all 19 Cukaricki U19 matches in 2019-20 and ranked T-4th on the team in goals (2). He scored both goals on September 22, 2019 against Vojvodina U19.

NATIONAL TEAM

Lukic represented Serbia on the U18, U19, U20 and U21 national teams from 2019-21, appearing in nine 2020 UEFA European U21 Championship tournament games and eight international friendly matches overall.

PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

Larsen joins Philadelphia from SK Brann, where he has spent the past three seasons competing in Norway's Eliteserien. He made 98 appearances in all competitions for Brann, scoring four goals, and played a key role during one of the most successful stretches in club history. Brann finished as runners-up in the Eliteserien in both the 2023 and 2024 seasons, while also lifting the Norwegian Cup in 2023. Larsen recorded 28 appearances and two goals during the 2023 campaign and followed that with 30 appearances in 2024 as the club repeated its second-place league finish. Prior to SK Brann, Larsen spent time in Lyngby Academy.

At the continental level, Larsen gained valuable European experience during the 2025 season, featuring in a UEFA Champions League Qualifying match against Salzburg and appearing in three UEFA Europa League group stage matches against Bologna FC, PAOK, and Fenerbahce. Brann concluded the 2025 league season in fourth place and entered the new year in contention to advance to the Round of 16 in the UEFA Europa League. Historically, Brann has been a mainstay in Norwegian football, competing in the country's topflight for 67 of its 80 seasons, the second most of any club in Denmark. Prior to joining Brann, Larsen featured for FC Midtjylland and FK Bodø/Glimt. Internationally, he has represented Denmark at the U16, U17, U18, U19, and U21 levels.

- Registered his first MLS assist vs CLT on 4/4 to become the fourth youngest player to record an assist in MLS history.

2025 MLS SEASON

- Made his first MLS start against NSH, becoming the second youngest to start a match in MLS history.

NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Made MLS NEXT Pro debut for Philadelphia Union II on March 24, 2024, and registered the game-winning assist.
- Helped the Philadelphia U-17 team win the 2024 Generation adidas Cup, including scoring the game-tying goal in the Final against the LA Galaxy.
- Sullivan scored three times and helped the U.S. outscore opponents, 26-5.
- Led the Union's U-17 side to an unbeaten 3-0-0 record at MLS NEXT Fest in December 2023, scoring and adding an assist while just 14 years old.
- Named to the 2023 Generation adidas Cup Best XI after starting for the Union's U-15 side while just 13 years old, helping them reach the championship match.

PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

Sullivan joined the Union Academy in 2020 and has quickly progressed through the Pro Player Pathway. He has featured for Union Academy's U15 MLS NEXT team, U17 MLS NEXT team, and Philadelphia Union II MLS NEXT Pro team, making a name for himself both with the Academy, as well as with United States Youth National Teams. In the 2023 Generation adidas Cup, Sullivan, who was just 13 years old at the time, helped the Union U15 squad reach the finals, beating academy powerhouses such as Valencia, Arsenal, and Real Madrid, with Sullivan scoring one minute into the match against Arsenal. With his outstanding play, he was named to the tournament's Best XI. This year, Sullivan joined the U17 squad where he contributed to the team winning their second-consecutive GA Cup championship. Additionally, in 2024 Sullivan featured for Union II, where he's appeared twice and added an assist in the game winning goal against New England Revolution II.

NATIONAL TEAM

In 2023, Sullivan led the US to victory in the 2023 Concacaf Boy's Under-15 Championship, marking the first time the US has ever won the tournament. The youngest player on the team, Sullivan's four goals scored earned him the Golden Ball as the best player in the tournament. In 2024, Sullivan was called up to the U.S. Under-17 Men's Youth National Team for a training camp in West Palm Beach, Florida.

Bueno made one appearance for the Union during the 2022 MLS season.

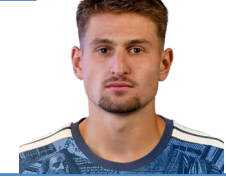
PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

Bueno played for Deportivo Lara in the first-tier Venezuelan division, Primera Division, since 2017. He made 75 total appearances for the Venezuelan side, scoring nine goals and logging three assists in that time.
