MATCHDAY HEADLINES

- New England leads the all-time regular season series with Toronto FC, 17-12-15, including a 6-7-6 record at BMO Field.
- The Revs have conceded 23 goals in 18 games, tied for fifth-fewest in MLS this season. Additionally, New England has allowed just nine second-half goals this season, the third-fewest leaguewide.
- Starting with Saturday's match, New England will play six of its next seven regular season contests on the road.
- F/W Jack Harrison** logged his Revolution debut last Saturday afternoon against Houston, coming off the bench in the second half and completing all four of his dribbles on the day. The English winger has tallied one assist in two career MLS starts against Toronto FC.
- M Carles Gil**'s next goal contribution will be the 150th of his MLS career. In 12 career appearances against Toronto FC, Gil owns four goals and two assists.
- GK Matt Turner** holds the second-best save percentage in the league this season (76.9), while his 80 saves rank third.
- F/W Griffin Yow** owns two goals and two assists in four career appearances against Toronto FC. His next appearance will mark the 50th match of his MLS career.
- D Mamadou Fofana** is tied for the MLS lead this season with 54 clearances. The Mali international center back (47) is approaching 50 MLS starts.
- F Marcos Zambrano** has started three consecutive games on the wing for New England.
- D Ethan Kohler** has started 13 of his 14 appearances and currently owns a 95 percent passing accuracy, the third highest in the league this season.

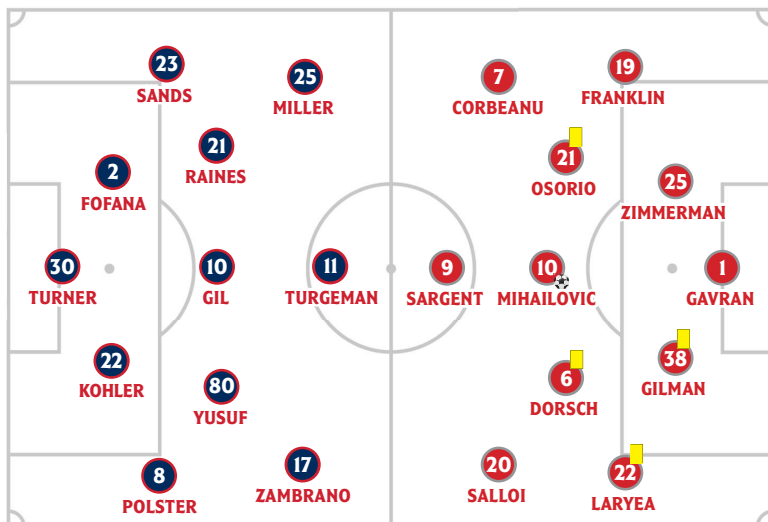

JACK HARRISON MAKES REVS DEBUT



The New England Revolution acquired English winger **Jack Harrison** from English Premier League club Leeds United FC and signed him to a Designated Player contract through the 2029-30 MLS season. Harrison, a U.S. Green Card holder, is designated as a domestic player on New England's roster.

The winger made his Revolution debut on August 8 at home against Houston Dynamo FC, coming off the bench in the second half to log 36 minutes in his first MLS appearance since 2017.

Harrison, 29, brings 11 years of professional experience across the top flights of England, Italy, and the United States. Across all competitions, the Englishman has registered 54 goals and 50 assists across more than 375 appearances with Leeds United, Everton, Middlesbrough, Italy's Fiorentina, and Major League Soccer's New York City FC. The left-footed winger has been a staple in the English Premier League with Leeds United and Everton, registering 181 appearances and 45 goal contributions in the English topflight.

A central figure at Leeds from 2018-2023, Harrison logged 219 total appearances and 66 goal involvements for the club, mostly in the Premier League with 83 additional games played in the English Championship, where he helped Leeds claim the 2019-20 title and promotion back to the first division in his second season with the club. Harrison played at least 35 matches in each of his five full seasons with the club.

Following his memorable tenure at Leeds, Harrison spent time on loan with Everton and most recently with Fiorentina in Italy's Serie A. He logged 73 overall appearances for Everton from 2023-25 in Premier League, FA Cup, and EFL Cup action. In his loan spell at Fiorentina during the first six months of 2026, Harrison recorded one goal and three assists in 22 games played, six coming in the UEFA Conference League.

A native of Stoke-on-Trent, England, Harrison featured for Manchester United youth teams before moving to Massachusetts at 14 to attend the Berkshire School in Sheffield. He played one year of collegiate soccer at Wake Forest before beginning his professional career in MLS at New York City FC after being selected first overall in the 2016 MLS SuperDraft. With NYCFC, Harrison logged 14 goals and 10 assists over 61 appearances, four of them in the MLS Cup Playoffs. In 2017, he played in every game of the MLS regular season and notched a career-high 10 goals.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING...

Revolution General Manager and Chief Soccer Officer Chris Tierney:

"Jack Harrison fills an important need for the Revolution as we aim to bolster our attack. Since breaking through in MLS, Jack has flourished on the game's biggest stages in the English Premier League and Serie A, where he was an integral part of his Leeds, Everton, and Fiorentina squads. With Jack joining the Revolution, we are confident his creativity and game intelligence will help him make an immediate impact."

Revolution Forward/Winger Jack Harrison:

"It was amazing to get back on the pitch. Obviously, it has been a while for myself being in a game but getting out there in front of the fans I feel like it was a really good reception that I received. I was super grateful to just get minutes. It was a difficult game, but it was good for me to just get that out of the way, hopefully push on now and continue improving in the performances."

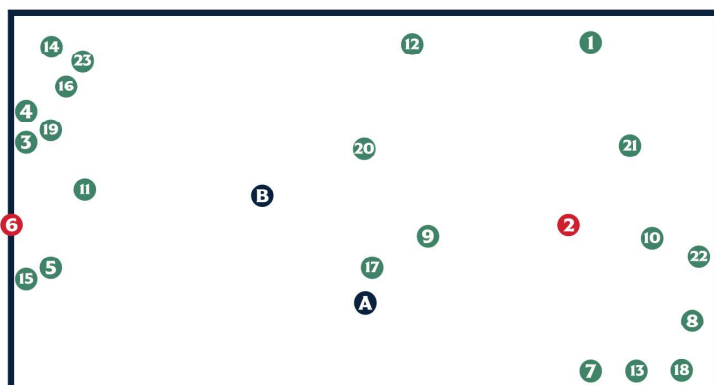

RETURN OF THE MATT: TURNER HERE TO STAY

The New England Revolution extended the loan of American goalkeeper **Matt Turner** as a TAM-eligible player from French club Olympique Lyonnais through Dec. 31, 2026, with an option to extend the loan as well as a purchase option. The goalkeeper rejoined the Revolution in July after representing the United States at the FIFA World Cup 2026. Turner has returned to top form this season, ranking top 10 among MLS goalkeepers in goals against average (1.28), victories (9), and clean sheets (4). Turner is also third leaguewide with 80 saves this season.

FOFANA & KOHLER HEADLINE REVS' STRONG BACKLINE

New England's center back duo of Mali international **Mamadou Fofana** and U.S. Youth international **Ethan Kohler** has formed a steady presence along the Revs' backline this season. Fofana appeared in 29 matches during his debut MLS campaign last season, and has started 17 of New England's 18 games to date in 2026. The duo have helped the Revs to a dominant defensive start, collecting five clean sheets this season.

Fofana scored his first Revolution goal on April 4 against CF Montreal, just the second goal of his professional career. On April 22, Fofana sparked the Revs backline with a season-high eight clearances to help preserve a 2-1 victory at Atlanta. His goal-line clearance to save a goal on May 9 vs. Philadelphia earned him a third selection to MLS Team of the Matchday this season. Fofana is tied for the MLS lead with 54 clearances.

Kohler, 21, is in his first MLS season and has quickly established himself as a dependable defender in MLS. A versatile defender and defensive midfielder, Kohler owns over 70 professional appearances to his credit with clubs in the United States and Germany. After arriving in Germany in 2023, Kohler played 34 matches for Werder Bremen II, helping win the 2023-24 Bremenliga title.

This season, Kohler has started 13 of his 14 MLS appearances, making his debut in the season opener on Feb. 21 at Nashville SC. He also notched a start in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup Round of 32 on April 14. Kohler has completed 786 of his 826 passes on the season, a 95.2 percent completion rate, second in MLS among players with at least 900 minutes played this season.

GO DIEGO GO: FAGUNDEZ RETURNS TO REVS

After five seasons away from club, veteran forward/winger **Diego Fagundez** officially returned to New England on March 13. Fagundez, who spent the first 10 seasons of his MLS career as the Revolution's first Homegrown Player signing, made an immediate impact with an assist off the bench in a 6-1 rout over FC Cincinnati on March 15.

A 16-year veteran in MLS, Fagundez has netted 79 goals along with 80 assists over 434 regular season appearances, 10th most on the MLS all-time list, between New England, Austin FC (2021-2023), and the LA Galaxy (2023-2025). His appearance and goal totals are both fourth among all active players, while his 159 goal contributions are the most in MLS today and the 15th most all-time.

OLIVEIRA THE LATEST REVS TEEN TO MAKE MLS DEBUT

Revolution midfielder **Cristiano Oliveira**, 18, made his MLS debut on May 23 at Charlotte FC. The Somerville, Mass. native made his club debut in the 2025 U.S. Open Cup, and has made nearly 40 appearances for Revolution II in MLS NEXT Pro action. Oliveira is one of three teenagers to earn MLS minutes for New England this year along with defender/winger **Peyton Miller** and midfielder **Eric Klein**. Oliveira was 18 years and 54 days old at the time of his debut, the fifth-youngest MLS debutant in club history.

RISING STARS: REVS LADEN WITH U.S. YOUTH INTERNATIONALS

New England's offseason acquisitions brought in a fresh crop of young, experienced talent. U22 midfielder **Brooklyn Raines** has four seasons in MLS to his credit. Raines, along with defender **Ethan Kohler**, have all seen action at the youth international level for the United States.

New England also acquired forward **Marcos Zambrano** from Real Salt Lake. Zambrano, 21, made his first two appearances for the Revolution in Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup action. The U.S. Youth international debuted on April 14, before scoring his first senior goal on April 29 against Orlando City SC. He has since appeared in four straight matches to begin the second half of the season, including three successive starts.

Kohler, Raines, Homegrown defender **Peyton Miller**, and New England's most recent acquisition Zambrano were all part of **Marko Mitrović's** roster at the 2025 FIFA U-20 World Cup. Several more Revs have earned youth international caps throughout their careers.

Additionally, Homegrown defender **Damarío McIntosh** has earned a pair of international call-ups to the Jamaica Under-20 National Team. McIntosh joined the squad in July to begin preparations for the 2026 Concacaf Under-20 Championship. The Reggae Boyz competed in the tournament in Mexico from July 24 to August 9.

MILLER ON THE CUSP OF HISTORIC MILESTONE

The New England Revolution re-signed Homegrown defender **Peyton Miller** to a multi-year contract extension through the 2028-29 MLS season with an additional club option for 2029-30. Miller, currently in his third MLS campaign after joining the Revolution Academy in 2021 at age 13, has twice been selected to the MLS 22 Under 22 class as one of the league's top young players.

Miller recently became the ninth-youngest player to reach 50 MLS games on July 25 against Atlanta United FC, and the third-youngest to score in that landmark appearance after **Diego Fagundez** (18 years, 206 days) for New England in 2013 and Alphonso Davies (17 years, 219 days) for the Vancouver Whitecaps in 2018.

Miller is seven regular season starts shy of becoming the fourth player in MLS history to start in 50 league matches prior to their 19th birthday, and the first to do so in 15 years.

FIFA WORLD CUP 2026 COMES TO BOSTON

FIFA World Cup 26™ was the largest to date, with 104 matches across three countries featuring 48 teams from around the world. The tournament featured matches in 16 Host Cities across the United States, Canada and Mexico, marking the fourth FIFA World Cup™ to be played on American soil and the second men's edition of the tournament ('94) hosted in the United States in addition to two FIFA Women's World Cups ('99 and '03).

The event saw Boston Stadium (Gillette Stadium) serve as the venue for five matches in FIFA World Cup 26™ group stage on June 13 (SCO 1-0 HAI), June 16 (IRQ 1-4 NOR), June 19 (MAR 1-0 SCO), June 23 (ENG 0-0 GHA), and June 26 (NOR 1-4 FRA).

Boston also hosted two matches in the knockout rounds, with one match each in the Round of 32 and Quarterfinals. On June 29, Paraguay handed Germany its first-ever loss in a penalty shootout to advance to the Round of 16. The Quarterfinal Round on July 9 saw France earn a second victory in Boston, defeating Morocco 2-0 in a rematch of the 2022 World Cup Semifinal.

MATT TURNER REPRESENTS UNITED STATES IN WORLD CUP

New England Revolution goalkeeper **Matt Turner** was selected to represent the United States Men's National Team at the 2026 FIFA World Cup. Turner featured on Head Coach Mauricio Pochettino's 26-man roster. Turner started in a tune-up match against Senegal on May 31, and started in the Group D finale against Türkiye on June 25.

Turner joined the *Stars & Stripes* for the FIFA World Cup for the second time, having started all four matches for the United States during the 2022 FIFA World Cup in Qatar. The 31-year-old goalkeeper helped the Americans advance to the Round of 16 in 2022 in Qatar, collecting consecutive shutout performances against England and Iran during the Group Stage - becoming the first American to keep back-to-back clean sheets in a World Cup since 1930.

A native of Park Ridge, N.J., Turner has carved a decorated resume on the international stage since suiting up for his United States debut in 2021. Turner has been capped 55 times by the United States, posting 27 clean sheets, with a 29-16-8 record. Turner's 14 clean sheets are a national team record through a player's first 20 caps, during which he backstopped the USMNT to the 2021 Concacaf Gold Cup title with five clean sheets in six starts. In total, Turner has collected 10 starts in Gold Cup action, three in Copa America, and 13 caps in Concacaf Nations League A action.

The addition of a second professional team has helped elevate the player development process by providing a fully defined pathway from the Academy to the professional ranks, facilitating growth through higher-level competition and a professional structure.

Launched in 2022 by Major League Soccer, MLS NEXT Pro is a professional men's soccer league in the United States and Canada that completes the pro player pathway from MLS NEXT to MLS first teams. The league continues to grow the game through innovation and inclusion, bringing professional soccer to new communities and creating opportunities both on and off the field. MLS NEXT Pro is playing its fifth season in 2026 with 30 teams.

BRING THE FIGHT

Marko Mitrović is in his first season as Head Coach of the New England Revolution in 2026, following his appointment to the position on Nov. 7, 2025. The 10th head coach in club history, Mitrović brings 15 years of coaching experience including successful tenures as a head coach for youth national teams of the United States and his native Serbia. As an assistant coach, Mitrović has four previous seasons of MLS experience with Chicago Fire FC, spent two years in the English Championship with Reading FC, and helped guide the Serbia Under-20 Men's National Team to a FIFA U-20 World Cup title.

Prior to joining New England, Mitrović compiled a 19-9-7 record as a head coach for the United States across multiple youth levels. He most recently led the U.S. Under-20 side to the 2025 FIFA U-20 World Cup quarterfinals in Chile, earning decisive 3-0 wins against two European powerhouses, France and Italy. Mitrović earned the opportunity after leading the United States Olympic Team at the 2024 Paris Games, where he also reached the quarterfinals. Mitrović joined U.S. Soccer as the head coach of the Under-19 team from 2022-23, winning all four of his friendly matches at the helm.

Mitrović, a UEFA Pro License holder, returns for his second stint in MLS after previously serving four years as an assistant coach for Chicago Fire FC from 2016-19 under compatriot Veljko Paunovic. He helped guide Chicago to a third-place finish in the Eastern Conference and the MLS Cup Playoffs in 2017. With the Fire, Mitrović worked with current Revolution midfielder Matt Polster for three seasons. While in Chicago, he also earned the opportunity to coach in the 2017 MLS All-Star Game against Real Madrid at Soldier Field.

After departing Chicago, Mitrović spent parts of two seasons as Paunovic's assistant with Reading FC, finishing seventh in the Championship his first year. During the 2021-22 season, Mitrović took charge for a pair of matches while Paunovic was out with illness, earning his first victory over Birmingham City on Nov. 6, 2021. At the club level, Mitrović has held roles as an assistant coach for Serbian clubs FK Banat Zrenjanin and FK Napredak Kruševac.

Hailing from Belgrade, Serbia, Mitrović earned his first head coaching opportunity with his boyhood academy, leading the Red Star Belgrade Under-15 side for two seasons from 2013-15. During his time with Red Star, Mitrović also

served as an assistant coach for the Serbia U-20 national team from 2012-15, and the U-15 side from 2014-16. The Serbia Under-20 team enjoyed sustained success during Mitrović's tenure, winning the 2015 FIFA U-20 World Cup with a victory over Brazil after extra time in the Final, and finishing third at the 2014 UEFA European U-19 Championship.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Mitrović played 16 seasons of professional football in Europe spanning clubs in Serbia, Hungary, Azerbaijan, and Kazakhstan. The former midfielder began his career in the esteemed Red Star Belgrade Academy, making his professional debut for the club in 1996 at 17 years old. During his youth career, Mitrović earned one call-up to the FR Yugoslavia Under-18 National Team for the 1995 UEFA European U-18 Championship, where he appeared in a pair of group stage victories over Austria and Georgia.

After featuring for multiple clubs in Serbia and one season in Hungary, Mitrović returned home to sign with FK Budućnost Banatski Dvor. In three seasons, Mitrović made 85 appearances, helping earn promotion to the Serbian top flight in 2002-03, a berth in the Serbian Cup Final in 2004, and qualification to the 2004-05 UEFA Europa League. Mitrović retired from professional football in 2010.

Mitrović, 48, became a naturalized U.S. Citizen in 2024 and is fluent in four languages – English, Spanish, Serbian, and Russian. He earned his education from the Mathematical Grammar School in his native Belgrade, graduating in 1997. Mitrović holds a UEFA Pro coaching license and has served as a UEFA Official Lecturer for both A and B license courses.

He is married to his wife, Marija, with whom he shares three children: Mitar, Matija, and Mia. His eldest son, Mitar, is a graduate student on the Men's Soccer Team at the University of Michigan after three years at Marquette University. His youngest son, Matija, is a midfielder for Portuguese Primeira Liga side Vitoria SC and spent time in the Chicago Fire FC Academy.

The youngest of three siblings, Mitrović comes from a family rooted in academics. His father, Stanko, was an engineer, a path also followed by his older brother Vladimir, who now resides in the United States. His sister, Jelena, is a surgeon, while his mother, Jelica, has a background in linguistics.



STAFF BIOS

MICHAEL MORRIS**ASSISTANT COACH**

Michael Morris is in his first season as an Assistant Coach with the New England Revolution. Hired following 16 years in the Seattle Sounders organization, the last five of which were spent with the club's developmental team, Tacoma Defiance, Morris reunites with Marko Mitrović after serving as his assistant with the United States Under-20 team in 2025, including at the 2025 FIFA U-20 World Cup in Chile.

Morris, 41, is a USSF A License holder who helped oversee the development of 18 first-team players during his time in Seattle, including notable names like Obed Vargas, Paul Rothrock, Jackson Ragen, and Danny Leyva. Morris entered the

coaching ranks in 2009 with the Seattle Sounders Academy. A longtime integral member of the club's development programs, he led the U-15, U-16, and U-19 sides during his tenure, while also serving as a lead scout.

After 11 years with the Sounders Academy, Morris was promoted to Assistant Coach and Head of Methodology for the club's developmental side, Tacoma Defiance, ahead of the 2021 campaign. Morris held the role for four seasons until being named interim head coach in July 2025. Throughout the 2025 season, Morris also spent time working alongside Mitrović as an assistant coach for the United States U-20 side. He was a member of the staff for the 2025 FIFA U-20 World Cup, in which the U.S. advanced to the Quarterfinals before falling to eventual champion Morocco. Following the U-20 World Cup, Morris served as head coach for the United States U-21 side in its return to international competition, leading the squad in a pair of friendly matches against Denmark and Serbia and November 2025.

As a player, Morris spent two seasons with the Seattle Sounders prior to their expansion into MLS. Morris was a member of the Sounders' 2007 USL First Division title-winning team. The Washington native turned professional following a successful four-year career at Seattle Pacific University. Over his four years, the Falcons posted a 49-21-7 record, won a share of the Great Northwest Athletic Conference in 2006, along with a pair of NCAA Tournament berths.

SEAN HUGHES**ASSISTANT COACH**

Sean Hughes is in his first season as an Assistant Coach with the New England Revolution. Hughes, who spent 14 seasons coaching at the collegiate level, reunites with Marko Mitrović after serving on his staff with the United States U-20 National Team for the 2025 FIFA U-20 World Cup.

Since 2024, Hughes had been the associate head coach of the University of Michigan men's soccer team. With the Wolverines, Hughes helped Michigan earn back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths in 2024 and 2025. Michigan also advanced to the Big Ten Tournament Final in 2024 and 2025, ending a five-year drought. During his time in Ann Arbor, Hughes also joined Mitrović and the U.S. U-20

staff for multiple camps leading up to the 2025 FIFA U-20 World Cup. In Chile, the Stars and Stripes reached the Quarterfinals, posting impressive 3-0 victories over France and Italy.

After one year as the head coach of the Maryville University men's soccer team in 2015, where his team set a single-season Division II record for wins and recorded the most shutouts in program history, Hughes accepted a position as an assistant coach with Marquette University at the Division I level. Hughes spent eight seasons with Marquette, the last four as associate head coach, where he also led the program's recruiting efforts. He helped the Golden Eagles reach three Big East Tournaments, an NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

Hughes, a native of Blackburn, England, entered the coaching ranks in 2012 with Quincy University in NCAA Division II, where he helped compile a 48-9-8 record, win two Great Lakes Valley Conference Championships, and reach the NCAA semifinals as the No. 3-ranked team nationally in 2014. During his time at Quincy, Hughes coached four All-Americans, two GLVC Freshmen of the Year, two GLVC Defensive Players of the Year, one GLVC Offensive Player of the Year, and more than 20 all-conference players.

BLAIR GAVIN**ASSISTANT COACH**

Blair Gavin is in his third season as an Assistant Coach with the New England Revolution. Hired on January 8, 2024, after one season as Head Coach of FC Tulsa in the USL Championship, Gavin, a former Revolution player, remains on staff under new Head Coach Marko Mitrović.

Gavin, 37, spent the 2023 season at the helm of FC Tulsa, leading the team to a 10-15-9 record. In his lone season with the club, Gavin was hired for his extensive knowledge of USL, MLS experience, and attack-minded style, with an ability to relate to both veterans and young players. Prior to his time with FC Tulsa, Gavin spent two seasons on staff with the Columbus Crew in MLS. Initially joining as a video analyst for the 2021 season, Gavin matriculated to a full-time assistant coach for the 2022 campaign where he served under his former college coach, Caleb Porter. In August of 2022, Gavin departed Columbus after being hired as Head Coach of FC Tulsa for the following year.

Gavin earned his first coaching opportunity in 2018 with Phoenix Rising FC after his retirement. The Scottsdale, Ariz. native joined Patrice Carteron's staff at just 29 years old, helping the club to a 54-16-14 record in league play during his three-year tenure. In his first season coaching Phoenix, Gavin helped guide the club to a Western Conference Championship and its first berth in the USL Cup Final. In 2019, Gavin and Phoenix finished with the best regular season record in the USL Championship. In his final season with Phoenix in 2020, Gavin helped the club reach the USL Cup Final once again, though the championship match was cancelled due to health and safety protocols.

As a player, Gavin spent eight seasons as a midfielder in MLS and the USL. He was originally selected by Chivas USA as the 10th-overall pick in the 2010 MLS SuperDraft, signing a Generation adidas contract. In parts of three seasons with Chivas, Gavin appeared in 43 matches, scoring three goals. Midway through the 2012 season, he was acquired by the New England Revolution and went on to make two appearances for the club.

KEVIN HITCHCOCK**GOALKEEPERS COACH**

Kevin Hitchcock is in his eighth season as Goalkeeper Coach with the New England Revolution, having joined the club on April 30, 2019. Hitchcock brings over 25 years of coaching experience to Marko Mitrović's staff, including time in the first divisions of England, Qatar, and India, as well as a decorated 18-year playing career in England.

With the Revolution, Hitchcock leads the coaching and development of the club's goalkeepers and has helped New England reach the playoffs in four of his seven seasons. During his tenure with the club, he has mentored two of the best shot-stoppers in league history in Matt Turner and

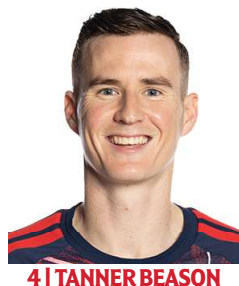
Djordje Petrović. Both goalkeepers made major strides in their development under Hitchcock's tutelage, resulting in multi-million-dollar transfers to the English Premier League clubs. At the time of Turner's move to Arsenal FC in 2021, it was the largest outgoing transfer fee for a goalkeeper in MLS history, a mark that Petrović surpassed when he made his move to Chelsea FC in 2023. Turner earned his first international experience while being coached by Hitchcock and went on to start for the U.S. Men's National Team at the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022.

With Hitchcock as their mentor, Turner (2020 and 2021) and Petrović (2022) finished in the top five of MLS Goalkeeper of the Year voting in four consecutive seasons (2019-22) and placed in the top two three years in a row (2020-22). Turner was named the 2021 Allstate MLS Goalkeeper of the Year after the club's historic Supporters' Shield campaign, when he backstopped the Revolution to a then-league-record 73 points. In 2020, Turner finished second in the voting as New England reached the Eastern Conference Final, while setting a new club record for lowest goals-against average.
