## MATCH STORYLINES

### Past Regular Season Match

Inter Miami picked a valuable 0-2 victory on the road over Real Salt Lake on Wednesday night at America First Field in Sandy, Utah, with stunners from midfielder Rodrigo De Paul and striker Luis Suárez securing the result. With the win, Inter Miami extended its current unbeaten run this regular season to eight, and improved its record on the road to five wins, a draw, and a loss for a total 16 points - the best record on the road this season in MLS.

Notably, Wednesday's win saw Academy product Noah Allen make Club history, as the Homegrown defender reached 119 appearances across all competitions and surpassed Drake Callender as the player with most appearances in Inter Miami history.

### Inter Miami this Regular Season

The team enters this weekend unbeaten in its past eight regular season games (5W, 3D). Overall, Inter Miami has recorded four five wins, one loss and three draws so far this MLS regular season for a total 18 points, and sits second in the Eastern Conference standings.

Messi, the reigning MLS Landon Donovan MVP Award and Golden Boot presented by Audi winner, has tallied seven goals so far and is tied for third amongst MLS top scorers this season. Midfielder Telasco Segovia, meanwhile, leads the team in assists so far this league campaign with five.

### Previously Against New England Revolution

On Saturday, the Herons will take on the Revs for the 11th time. Inter Miami leads the series to date, having recorded seven wins and three losses.

Inter Miami will look to extend its current winning run after securing victory in the past four meetings. Last time out, the teams faced off in MLS regular season this past October, with Inter Miami coming out on top 4-1 at home.

### Scouting New England Revolution

New England Revolution will visit Nu Stadium for the first time after defeating Atlanta United 1-2 on the road on Wednesday. In all, the Revs have recorded five wins and three losses this regular season for a total 15 points, and are currently third in the Eastern Conference table.

Defender Peyton Miller leads the team in goals this regular season with three, while forward Luca Langoni leads in assists with six.

## 2026 MLS Player of the Matchday Honorees:

**Matchday 2:** Messi clocked in another influential performance in our first road win over our rivals (W,2-4 @ Orlando). Two bangers from the Argentine maestro, with a goal from outside the box in the 57th minute and a free kick to the bottom-left corner in the 90th minute, were key in helping Inter Miami achieve the thrilling 2-4 comeback victory. This marks the 13th time in his career that Messi has been named MLS Player of the Matchday, which is the third-most in league history, behind only Landon Donovan (19) and Jeff Cunningham (14). Since the start of 2024, approximately one in every six Player of the Matchday awards has been won by Messi.

**Matchday 8:** Messi played an influential role with a brace in Inter Miami's 2-3 road win over Colorado. Our captain first opened the scoring from the penalty spot in the 18th minute of play, before scoring our winning-goal in spectacular fashion in the 80th minute. This marks the 14th time in his career that Messi has been named MLS Player of the Matchday and it is his second award this season after earning the honor on Matchday 2. Messi is now tied with Jeff Cunningham (14) for the second-most Player of the Matchday awards in MLS history, behind only Landon Donovan (19).

Acquired: Signed by Inter Miami on January 16, 2025

- A product of San Lorenzo's renowned youth academy, he made his professional debut in 2021 and quickly established himself as a key player for the club. Capable of playing as both a center-back and right-back, Luján showcased his defensive reliability registering 97 appearances for San Lorenzo.
- During the 2024 CONMEBOL Pre-Olympic Tournament, Luján shared the roster with his teammate Rocco Ríos Novo. Under the management of Mascherano, they achieved a second-place finish in the tournament, securing qualification for the 2024 Paris Olympic Games. He subsequently was selected by Mascherano to compete at the 2024 Paris Summer Olympics.
- In 2025, Luján registered 40 appearances across all competitions in his first season at Inter Miami as he helped the Club clinch a historic first MLS Cup title.

- Reguilón joined Inter Miami after previously featuring in two of Europe's most prestigious leagues — LaLiga and the English Premier League — in addition to building a strong background across major international competitions, including the UEFA Champions League, UEFA Europa League, and the FIFA Club World Cup. Over the course of his professional career, the defender has made more than 260 appearances, including 81 in the Premier League and 56 in LaLiga.
- The left back also provides championship experience after winning the 2018 FIFA Club World Cup title with Real Madrid and the 2024/25 UEFA Europa League with Sevilla.
- Reguilón began his career in the youth ranks of Real Madrid CF, spending 10 years progressing through the club's academy and going out on loan before making his first-team debut in October 2018 in a UEFA Champions League match. He subsequently also played for Sevilla FC, Tottenham Hotspur, Atlético de Madrid, Manchester United, and Brentford FC.

- Mura joined Inter Miami after a successful spell with Racing Club (2022-2025), while previously also playing for Club Estudiantes de La Plata (2019-2021) and Club Atlético Colón (2020-2021 on loan) in his native Argentina, making a total 200 appearances across all competitions while recording 13 goals and 20 assists.
- The defender, who predominantly performs at right back, provides further championship winning experience to our squad, having won the 2025 Recopa Sudamericana, the 2024 Copa Sudamericana, and 2022 Trofeo de Campeones de la Liga Profesional with Racing, and the 2021 Copa de la Liga Profesional with Colón.
- Mura has also gained experience on the international front, representing Argentina's youth sides and notably being part of the 2020 CONMEBOL South American U-20 Championship winning squad and competing at the 2019 FIFA U-20 World Cup in Poland.

- Joined the Club on loan through the 2025 Major League Soccer (MLS) season; the deal includes an option to make the transfer permanent through the 2029 MLS season.
- De Paul joins Inter Miami with a formidable resume both at the club and international levels. Internationally, he was one of the main figures alongside Inter Miami captain Lionel Messi in Argentina's historic 2022 FIFA World Cup title, as well as in La Albiceleste's 2021 and 2024 CONMEBOL Copa América and 2022 CONMEBOL-UEFA Cup of Champions conquests.
- At the club level, the midfield engine has racked up nearly 500 appearances across all competitions and tallied 57 goals and 74 assists, representing Racing Club in his native Argentina (2012-2014, 2016 on loan) before an accomplished spell in Europe, playing for Valencia CF (2014-2016), Udinese (2016-2021) and Club Atlético de Madrid (2021-2025).
- De Paul was a key player throughout the second half of the season as Inter Miami went on to clinch the MLS Cup title. In all, he made 23 appearances in his first half season at the Club, contributing two goals and seven assists along the way.

He scored an impressive total of 195 goals and added 113 assists over 283 matches with the club. Suarez is also one of the most accomplished players in his country's history. He guided Uruguay to a prestigious Conmebol Copa América title in 2011, and retired as his nation 's leading scorer (69) and as the second most capped player with 143 appearances.
- The striker has continued to shine during his stint with Inter Miami. In all, he's tallied a notable 42 goals - the second most in Club history - and 30 assists in 87 appearances across all competitions for Inter Miami, lifting the 2024 Supporters' Shield trophy while securing the MLS single-season points record and the 2025 MLS Cup in the process.
