### New England Revolution Trade Tomás Chancalay to Minnesota United FC

*Revolution receive \$100,000 and retain portion of Chancalay's sell-on rights*

**FOXBOROUGH, Mass.** (December 26, 2025) – The New England Revolution acquired \$100,000 in a cash-for-player trade with Minnesota United FC for forward **Tomás Chancalay**. New England also retains a percentage of any future transfer fees received for Chancalay.

“On behalf of the Revolution, I’d like to thank Tomás for his contributions during his time with our club,” Sporting Director Curt Onalfo said. “We wish him and his family all the best as he begins this next chapter with Minnesota.”

Chancalay arrived in New England on loan in July 2023 and finalized a permanent transfer later that November. Across parts of three seasons with the club, the Argentine attacker recorded 12 goals and three assists over 49 MLS appearances, including 33 starts. Last season, Chancalay tallied four goals and two assists in 26 matches, with 12 starts.

The Revolution will travel to Florida on Jan. 13 to begin preseason training ahead of the 2026 Major League Soccer season. The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Through 30 MLS seasons, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. The Revolution also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles. The Revolution play their home matches at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. The club and its acclaimed pro pathway, including Revolution II (MLS NEXT Pro) and the Revolution Academy, are headquartered at the Revolution Training Center, which opened ahead of the 2020 season.
