Revolution Players to Attend Special Olympics Unified Soccer Team Tryouts on Sunday

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. (March 27, 2026) – The New England Revolution and Special Olympics Massachusetts (SOMA) are launching the 12th season of the Revolution Unified Soccer Team with their annual open tryout on **Sunday, March 29**, from **1:00 - 3:00 p.m. ET** at the **WIN Waste Innovations Field House** at Patriot Place. Revolution players **Andrew Farrell** and **J.D. Gunn** will be in attendance to help run the soccer clinic alongside Revolution Academy coaches.

The SOMA athletes and Unified Sports Partners, ages 16-24, will play two matches against Toronto FC's Unified Team this season. The 2026 Revolution Unified Team will host Toronto on Wednesday, July 22, before visiting the Canadian side on Saturday, August 15. The entire 2026 Revolution Unified squad will be formally introduced during the team's annual Signing Day event on May 6 at 3:30 p.m.
