GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. New York Red Bulls

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FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (1-5-1, 4 pts.) return home this weekend to host the New York Red Bulls (1-3-2, 5 pts.) on Saturday, April 20 at Gillette Stadium. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston, with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama calling the action. Authenticated subscribers may also stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest airs locally on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub HD2 broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary. The Revs will continue a three-game homestand and will look for their second consecutive home win against the Red Bulls, after playing to a 2-1 win at Gillette Stadium last season on June 2, 2018, courtesy of strikes from Teal Bunbury and Diego Fagundez.

As part of MLS WORKS Greener Goals Week of Service, for the third consecutive year, all 24 MLS clubs will be wearing special adidas x Parley eco-friendly kits during Earth Day weekend. The Revolution will wear the Parley kits during Saturday's test against the Red Bulls. As part of the global adidas x Parley initiative, plastic waste collected on beaches and in coastal communities is transformed into high-performance sportswear. As one of only a few MLS clubs located in a coastal community, the Revolution have participated in multiple events this week to promote ocean conservation. On Monday, April 15, Diego Fagundez and Antonio Delamea joined forces with the New England Aquarium to visit sea turtles at the animal rescue facility in Quincy, Mass., before then feeding rescued turtle Myrtle at the aquarium. On Wednesday, four Revolution players, members of the front office, and volunteers Special Olympics Massachusetts and Arbella Insurance spent time cleaning up debris at Squaw Rock in Quincy.

In addition, the New England Revolution and New England Revolution Charitable Foundation will once again host their annual Charitable Drive Series presented by Audi, this upcoming season at Gillette Stadium, beginning with Saturday's match. During select matches throughout the 2019 season, the Revolution will hold one drive each month, collecting much-needed soccer items for local charitable organizations throughout the region, including Boston Scores and Boston Centers for Youth & Families.

Following Saturday's match, the Revolution will conclude their three-game home stretch with the season's first matchup with the Montreal Impact on Wednesday, April 24. That mid-week match will kick off at 7:30 p.m. ET on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday’s match against New York Red Bulls. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday’s match.

- The Revs (62), and **M Carles Gil** (19) as an individual, continuing to pace MLS in possessions gained in the attacking third.
- **Gil** moving up the league charts for chances created, where he ranks third in MLS with 18.
- **D Andrew Farrell** eclipsing the 17,000-minute threshold for his MLS career. He needs two more minutes of action to become the sixth player in club history to reach that milestone.
- **F Teal Bunbury** playing 73 minutes to reach 15,000 for his MLS career. With one more goal, Bunbury would also tie Kelyn Rowe for ninth-most goals scored in Revolution history (29).
- **M Diego Fagundez** scoring once to tie Lee Nguyen for the second most goals scored in Revolution history (51).
