GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. Montreal Impact

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FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (2-5-1, 7 pts.) return home this weekend to host the Montreal Impact (3-3-2, 11 pts.) on Wednesday, March 24 at Gillette Stadium. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston, with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama calling the action. Authenticated subscribers may also stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest airs locally on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub HD2 broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

The Revs are back at home this week to conclude a three-match homestand, and will look to claim a second consecutive victory at Gillette Stadium after earning a 1-0 win against the New York Red Bulls on April 20. The club owns a home record of 4-0-0 against the Impact since 2016, having earned three points in the sides' last meeting on October 28, 2018. Diego Fagundez scored a 74th-minute goal to secure the win and end the Revs' 2018 home campaign on a positive note. In just three weeks, New England will face Montreal in the teams' second and final matchup of the season on May 18 at Stade Saputo.

Following Wednesday's match, the Revolution will begin a three-game road stretch with the season's lone matchup against Sporting Kansas City on Saturday, April 27 at Children's Mercy Park. That match will kick off at 8:30 p.m. ET on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.
