GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. San Jose Earthquakes *@NERevolution, #NERevs, #NEvSJ, #SalutetoHeroes*

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (2-8-2, 8 pts.) will host the San Jose Earthquakes (3-5-2, 11 pts.) on Saturday, May 11 at Gillette Stadium. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston, with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama calling the action. Authenticated subscribers may also stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest airs locally on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

On Saturday, New England will take the field for the first time under the guidance of Mike Lapper, who took over interim head coaching responsibilities after Brad Friedel was relieved of his duties on Thursday. The Revs will look to rebound from Wednesday's defeat at Chicago with a victory against San Jose, which enters the weekend unbeaten in four straight matches (2-0-2). The Western Conference side holds a 14-20-8 advantage in the all-time regular season series, though the Revs own a 2-0-1 record in Foxborough against the original MLS club since 2013.

Saturday also marks the Revolution's annual "Salute to Heroes" night, as the club has once again partnered with USO New England to recognize local military personnel, police, fire, and first responders. In addition to providing members of these groups with tickets to the match and several in-game moments of recognition, the club will also host an online auction featuring match-worn and autographed items to benefit USO New England.

Following Saturday's contest, New England will turn its attention to English powerhouse Chelsea FC and the "Final Whistle on Hate" charity match at Gillette Stadium on Wednesday, May 15. That match begins at 8:00 p.m. ET and will be nationally televised on FS1, while also airing locally on the radio on 98.5 The Sports Hub.
