## **GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution at Orlando City SC**

*Revs travel to face Lions in U.S. Open Cup Round of 16*

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution will travel to Florida to face Orlando City SC in the Round of 16 of the 2019 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup on Wednesday, June 19 at Exploria Stadium in Orlando. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be streamed live for subscribers on ESPN+.

Wednesday's contest will mark the 10<sup>th</sup> all-time meeting between New England and Orlando City SC, and their first in U.S. Open Cup play. The Revolution hold a 3-2-4 record against the 2015 expansion side, with a 0-2-3 mark in away matches. Overall, New England is 21-16-5 in the tournament, including an 8-11-2 mark in away matches and an 8-11-1 record against MLS opposition. Revolution Sporting Director and Head Coach Bruce Arena won the Open Cup in 1996 with D.C. United, while Orlando City Head Coach James O'Connor topped New England in the tournament once before, when his Louisville City FC side beat the Revolution in 2018 Fourth Round, 3-2.

New England advanced to the Round of 16 by defeating the New York Red Bulls, 3-2, after extra time in the Fourth Round at MSU Soccer Park in Montclair, N.J. Forward Juan [Agudelo opened the scoring](#) for the visitors, while Teal Bunbury's late heroics with an [85<sup>th</sup>-minute equalizer](#) and [game-winning goal](#) in extra time after the Revs went down to 10 men sealed the win. Goalkeeper Matt Turner also played a pivotal role, coming up with a [penalty save](#) in the second half.

Following Wednesday's Open Cup match, New England will return to MLS regular season play with a two-match homestand against the Philadelphia Union on Wednesday, June 26 (7:00 p.m. ET), and the Houston Dynamo on Saturday, June 29 (7:30 p.m. ET). Both matches will air locally on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

- New England building on its 21-16-5 record in 42 total games in U.S. Open Cup competition, including an 8-11-2 mark in away matches and an 8-11-1 record against MLS opposition.
- The Revs playing their first-ever U.S. Open Cup matchup against Orlando City SC in the clubs' 10<sup>th</sup> overall meeting.
- **Sporting Director and Head Coach Bruce Arena** making his third appearance on the Revolution sideline. Arena is 2-0-0 across all competitions on the New England bench, beating the LA Galaxy, 2-1, in league play and the New York Red Bulls, 3-2, in the Fourth Round of the Open Cup.
- **F Teal Bunbury** scoring the seventh U.S. Open Cup goal of his Revolution career, tying Taylor Twellman for the most in franchise history. Bunbury has three goals in the team's last two games across all competitions, and tallied the game-winning strikes in both of them.
- **M Diego Fagundez** making his 17<sup>th</sup> career U.S. Open Cup appearance and remaining the all-time leader in Revs history for Open Cup games played.
- **Bunbury, Fagundez, and Juan Agudelo** breaking a three-way tie for career scoring by a Revolution player against Orlando. All three players own three goals and one assist apiece against the Lions.
