Dor Turgeman Called up to Israel Men's National Team

Revolution forward owns 17 caps with Israel

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. (May 28, 2026) – New England Revolution forward Dor Turgeman has been called in to the Israel Men's National Team for a training camp and friendly match in Albania during FIFA's June international window. Turgeman and Israel will take on Albania in an international friendly on Wednesday, June 3 (2:00 p.m. ET).



Turgeman, 22, has scored two goals over 17 senior caps with the Israel Men's National Team, after featuring extensively for his country's youth national teams. The striker tallied twice in his seven appearances during the recent UEFA World Cup Qualifying cycle. Turgeman most recently suited up against Georgia in a March 2026 friendly.

With New England, the six-foot-one forward has scored five goals with four assists through 16 MLS appearances. This season, Turgeman has started all 14 games with two goals and three helpers. After tallying in all three of his appearances to close the 2025 season, he notched a goal in the 2026 home opener to become only the fourth Revolution player to score in each of his first four home games.

The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Through 30 MLS seasons, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. New England also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles. The Revolution play their home matches at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. The club and its acclaimed pro pathway, including Revolution II (MLS NEXT Pro) and the Revolution Academy, are headquartered at the Revolution Training Center, which opened ahead of the 2020 season.
