GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. Atlanta United FC *@NERevolution, #NEREvs, #NEvATL*

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (5-4-3, 18 pts.) are back in Foxborough for two home matches this week, beginning with a contest against Atlanta United FC (8-3-1; 25 pts.) on Wednesday evening. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama on the call. Authenticated subscribers may also stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest also airs on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

Saturday's match will be the first of two meetings between New England and Atlanta in 2018, with the second contest slated for Oct. 6 at Mercedes-Benz Stadium. In their last meeting on Sept. 30, 2017, the two sides played to a scoreless draw at Gillette Stadium. Teal Bunbury enters the match as New England's leading scorer with six goals in the club's last nine games. Should Bunbury record a brace, he will tie Clint Dempsey for 10th most goals (25) in club history.

Following Wednesday's contest, the Revs will have a quick turnaround before they square off with the New York Red Bulls on Saturday, June 2 at Gillette Stadium. That match will kick off at 7:30 p.m. ET, and will be broadcast locally on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Wednesday's match against Atlanta United FC. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Wednesday's match.

- **New England** claiming a win over Atlanta for the first time in club history and remaining unbeaten against Atlanta at home (0-0-1).
- The **Revolution** tallying at least two goals for the ninth time through the first 12 matches. The club is 4-1-3 when scoring at least two goals this season.
- Forward **Teal Bunbury** finding the net for the seventh time in the club's last 10 games. Bunbury has scored in six-of-nine games dating back to March 31 at Houston.
- **Bunbury** registering a brace to tie Clint Dempsey for the 10th most goals (25) in club history.
- Forward **Cristian Penilla** recording an assist to become the seventh player in MLS this season to record at least five goals and five assists.
- There are a few notable connections between the Revolution and Atlanta:
 - Revolution players **Juan Agudelo** and **Kelyn Rowe** played with Atlanta United midfielder **Darlington Nagbe** and goalkeeper **Brad Guzan** and for the USMNT during the 2017 CONCACAF Gold Cup.
 - Revolution forward **Teal Bunbury** and midfielder **Scott Caldwell** were teammates with Atlanta United midfielder **Darlington Nagbe** at the University of Akron.
 - Atlanta United FC captain and defender **Michael Parkhurst** played for the Revolution from 2005-08. Parkhurst is also a native of Providence, R.I.
 - Atlanta United FC midfielder **Jeff Larentowicz** played for the Revolution from 2005-09. Both Larentowicz and Parkhurst helped New England to consecutive MLS Cup appearances in 2006 and 2007.
 - Atlanta United FC defender **Miles Robinson** is a native of Arlington, Mass.
