## GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. New York Red Bulls

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (5-4-4, 19 pts.) are set to play the club's third match in eight days against the New York Red Bulls (7-3-1; 22 pts.) at Gillette Stadium on Saturday evening. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama on the call. Authenticated subscribers may stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest also airs on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

Saturday's contest will be the first of two meetings between New England and the Red Bulls in 2018, with the second match scheduled for July 21 at Red Bull Arena. In their last MLS meeting on July 5, 2017, the Red Bulls defeated the Revolution, 3-2, at Gillette Stadium. Teal Bunbury enters this weekend's match as New England's leading scorer with seven goals in the club's last 10 games, including three in the last four. Bunbury has three career goals and three assists in 15 regular season games against the Red Bulls.

Saturday also marks the Revolution's second official Pride Night, helping kick off Boston Pride Week from June 1-10. The annual celebration of the LGBTQ community and its allies is held in partnership with the Midnight Riders and [You Can Play](#). A special ticket package that includes a Pride Night scarf is available at <https://www.revolutionsoccer.net/pride-night>, with a portion of all proceeds benefitting You Can Play.

Following Saturday's match, the Revs will begin preparations for a U.S. Open Cup Fourth Round matchup with USL side Louisville City FC. That match will take place at the University of Louisville's Lynn Stadium on Tuesday, June 5 and will kick off at 7:00 p.m. ET. All U.S. Open Cup matches are broadcast on USSoccer.com. Next in MLS play, the Revs will travel to play the Chicago Fire on Saturday, June 9. That match will kick off at 8:30 p.m. ET, and will be broadcast locally on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

**WHAT TO WATCH FOR**

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against the New York Red Bulls. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday's match.

- **New England** snapping a three-match losing streak against the Red Bulls in MLS regular season play.
- The **Revolution** tallying at least two goals for the ninth time through the first 13 matches. The club is 4-1-3 when scoring at least two goals this season.
- Forward **Teal Bunbury** finding the net for the eighth time in the club's last 11 games. Bunbury has scored in seven-of-10 games dating back to March 31 at Houston.
- Forward **Cristian Penilla** recording either one goal or one assist to become the 10th MLS player with 10 combined goals and helpers this season.
- There are a few notable connections between the Revolution and New York:
  - Revolution forward **Juan Agudelo** was the second Homegrown Player signing in New York Red Bulls history. Agudelo, who signed with the first team in 2010 at age 17, made 33 appearances in two-plus seasons with the Red Bulls, registering six goals and two assists.
  - Revolution forward **Teal Bunbury** played alongside Red Bulls defender **Aurélien Collin** with Sporting Kansas City from 2011-13.
  - Red Bulls goalkeeper coach **Preston Burpo** played for the Revolution in 2010, recording a 2-6-2 record in 11 appearances.
