GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution at San Jose Earthquakes *@NERevolution, #NERevs, #SjvNE*

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (6-4-5, 23 pts.) will conclude their two-match road trip with a midweek contest against the San Jose Earthquakes (2-9-3; 9 pts.) at Avaya Stadium on Wednesday evening. The match kicks off at 10:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston with Brad Feldman and Paul Mariner on the call. Authenticated subscribers may stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest also airs on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

Wednesday's match will be the lone meeting between the Revolution and the Earthquakes in 2018. The Revs are unbeaten in five matches against the Earthquakes dating back to 2013. Each of the previous two MLS meetings between the two sides ended in scoreless draws. Teal Bunbury enters Wednesday's match as New England's leading scorer with nine goals, including goals in four consecutive matches. Kelyn Rowe leads active Revolution players in goals scored against San Jose with two.

New England will return to MLS action on Saturday, June 30 to square off with D.C. United at Gillette Stadium. Kickoff for that game is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. ET, and will be broadcast locally on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Wednesday's match against the San Jose Earthquakes. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Wednesday's match.

- The **Revolution** claiming at least a point on the road for the fifth time through the club's first seven away matches in 2018 (1-2-3).
- Forward **Teal Bunbury** registering a goal for a fifth consecutive match. Bunbury has found the net five times in the club's last six games and has scored in nine-of-12 games dating back to March 31 at Houston. Taylor Twellman scored in a club-record six consecutive games from April 20 - May 25, 2002.
- Midfielder **Diego Fagundez** scoring a goal and recording an assist to make the Revolution the second team in MLS to boast two five-goal and five-assist players on the year. Fagundez (4G, 4A) and **Cristian Penilla** (5G, 5A) would join LAFC's Carlos Vela (7G, 5A) and Diego Rossi (5G, 6A) in reaching the feat.
- Midfielder **Kelyn Rowe** breaking a tie with defender **Chris Tierney** at third place on the club's all-time assists chart with 40 career helpers apiece.
- There are a few notable connections between the Revolution and San Jose:
 - Earthquakes assistant coach **Steve Ralston** played for the Revolution from 2002-09. Ralston is New England's all-time leader in assists (73). He also ranks among the top five in club history in games started (196), minutes played (17,643), and goals (42).
 - Revolution defender **Jalil Anibaba** and Earthquakes forward **Quincy Amarikwa** were teammates on the Chicago Fire in 2014.
 - Revolution goalkeeper **Cody Cropper** and Earthquakes defender **Jackson Yueill** are both products of the Minnesota Thunder academy.
