GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. LA Galaxy

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (7-4-7, 28 pts.) are set to conclude their three-match homestand against the LA Galaxy (7-7-4, 25 pts.) at Gillette Stadium on Saturday. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama on the call. Authenticated subscribers may stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest also airs on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

Saturday's match will be the lone meeting between New England and LA in 2018. New England will look to extend its seven-match unbeaten streak and defeat the Galaxy at Gillette Stadium for the second time in as many years. The Galaxy enter Saturday's match on a five-game unbeaten streak with LA most recently defeating Columbus, 4-0, on July 7.

Following Saturday's match, the Revolution will prepare for a midweek clash with Minnesota United FC at TCF Bank Stadium on Wednesday, July 18. Kickoff for that game is scheduled for 8:00 p.m. ET, and will be broadcast locally on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against the LA Galaxy. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday's match.

- The **Revolution** (28 pts.) eclipsing the 30-point threshold after 19 MLS games for only the fourth time in club history. The last time the Revs accomplished the feat was in 2008 (16 games).
- **New England** extending its unbeaten run in MLS play to eight matches, having posted a 2-0-5 mark in the last seven games. That would match the club's longest streak since an eight-game stretch in 2015 (July 18 - Sept. 16).
- Forward **Teal Bunbury** finding the net for the 11th time in the club's last 16 games. Bunbury has scored in five times in the club's last seven matches.
- Midfielder **Diego Fagundez** recording two assists to become the third member of the Revolution's 40G/40A club, where he would join Lee Nguyen (51G/49A) and Steve Ralston (42G/73A).
- Goalkeeper **Matt Turner** vaulting into the league's top five keepers in saves this season. He currently ranks tied for sixth with 61 stops.
- There are a pair of notable connections between the Revolution and LA:
 - LA Galaxy head coach **Sigi Schmid** identified Revolution head coach **Brad Friedel** as a high schooler and recruited him to play at UCLA. Friedel played four years at UCLA under Schmid, and led the team to an NCAA championship in 1990. In 1992, Friedel was awarded the MAC Hermann Trophy as the nation's top collegiate player.
 - Revolution midfielder **Kelyn Rowe** and LA Galaxy goalkeeper **Brian Rowe** were teammates at UCLA from 2010-11.
