GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution at D.C. United

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FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (7-8-8, 29 pts.) will take on D.C. United in the Revs' first ever visit to Audi Field on Sunday, Aug. 19. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on FS1, as well as locally on the radio on 98.5 The Sports Hub with Brad Feldman and Paul Mariner on the call. The contest airs on the radio in Portuguese on 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

The Revolution and D.C. will face off for the second and final time this season on Sunday, as New England currently holds a five-point advantage over the Black and Red in the Eastern Conference standings. On June 30, the Revs claimed victory in the first meeting, 3-2, at Gillette Stadium courtesy of a Cristian Penilla brace and a goal from Teal Bunbury. New England posted a 10-25-5 overall record at D.C.'s former home, RFK Stadium, and will play at Audi Field for the first time since it opened on July 14.

Following Sunday's match, the Revolution will return to action on Saturday, Aug. 25 against the Philadelphia Union in Chester, Pa. The clubs' third and final meeting of the season will kick off at 7:30 p.m. ET on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Sunday's match against D.C. United. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Sunday's match.

- The Revolution winning back-to-back regular season games against D.C. for the first time since the 2013 season, and completing a season sweep of the Black and Red for the first time since 2011 (2-0-0).
- The club boasting at least two 10-goal scorers for the second straight year, and the fifth time in club history. **Teal Bunbury** has 11 goals while **Cristian Penilla** (9) and **Diego Fagundez** (7) are approaching the double-digit mark. The Revs have never had three players with 10-or-more goals in the same campaign.
- Midfielder **Diego Fagundez** recording two more goals to become the youngest MLS player to reach 50 career regular season goals, per the Elias Sport Bureau.
- Defender **Jalil Anibaba** playing all 90 minutes in a 23rd straight match. Anibaba has contributed a full shift in each of his 22 starts this season and only missed the first 27 minutes of the season before entering the opener as a substitute.
- There are two notable connections between the Revolution and D.C.:
 - Revolution Head Coach **Brad Friedel** and D.C. Head Coach Ben Olsen were teammates on the U.S. Men's National Team at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia.
 - Revolution defender **Andrew Farrell** and D.C. midfielder Nick DeLeon were teammates at the University of Louisville from 2010-11.
