GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution at Philadelphia Union *@NERevolution, #NEREvs, #PHIVNE*

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (7-9-8, 29 pts.) will travel to Pennsylvania to take on the Philadelphia Union (10-11-3, 33 pts.) in the clubs' third and final meeting of the season on Saturday, Aug. 25. The match kicks off at 7:00 p.m. ET at Talen Energy Stadium and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston with Brad Feldman and Paul Mariner calling the action. Authenticated subscribers may stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest airs on the radio with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

Entering the weekend, the Union hold a four-point advantage over the Revs in the Eastern Conference standings as New England looks to gain ground in the table. In the season opener on March 3, the Union earned a 2-0 win at Talen Energy Stadium against a nine-man Revs side. New England holds a 6-12-4 all-time record against Philadelphia and will face the Union for the second time in three weeks after a 3-2 loss at Gillette Stadium on Aug. 11.

Following Saturday's match, the Revolution will return to action on Saturday, Sept. 1 against the Portland Timbers at Gillette Stadium. The clubs' only meeting of the season will kick off at 7:30 p.m. ET on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against Philadelphia. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday's match.

- The Revolution claiming their first win against the Union since July 29, 2017 when **Scott Caldwell** tallied two assists and **Juan Agudelo** scored a late goal in a 3-0 home victory.
- The club boasting at least two 10-goal scorers for the second straight year and the fifth time in club history. **Teal Bunbury** has 11 goals while **Cristian Penilla** (9) and **Diego Fagundez** (7) are approaching the double-digit mark. The Revs have never had three 10-goal scorers in the same campaign.
- Midfielder **Diego Fagundez** recording two more goals to become the youngest MLS player to reach 50 career regular season goals, per the Elias Sport Bureau.
- **Fagundez** continuing to lead all active Revs players in career goals (4) and assists (5) against Philadelphia.
- There are a pair of notable connections between the Revs and Union:
 - Union assistant coach **Pat Noonan** played five seasons and made 136 MLS appearances with the Revolution after the club selected him with the ninth-overall pick in the 2003 MLS SuperDraft.
 - Revolution forward **Teal Bunbury** and Union forward **C.J. Sapong** were teammates with Sporting Kansas City from 2011-13.
