GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. Orlando City SC

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (8-12-11, 35 pts.) return home for a meeting with Orlando City SC (7-19-4, 25 pts.) in the club's penultimate home match of the season on Saturday, Oct. 13. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET at Gillette Stadium and will be televised locally on NBC Sports Boston, with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama calling the action. Authenticated subscribers may stream the match on NBCSportsBoston.com and on the NBC Sports app. The contest airs nationally on the radio on SiriusXM FC Channel 157, and locally with 98.5 The Sports Hub broadcasting the action in English and 1260 AM Nossa Radio providing Portuguese commentary.

New England enters Saturday's match unbeaten in three all-time home meetings with Orlando City, posting a 2-0-1 record at Gillette Stadium since the Lions joined the league in 2015. In the clubs' first meeting this season, the Revs played Orlando to a 3-3 draw on Aug. 4 at Orlando City Stadium, earning a point courtesy of strikes from Juan Agudelo, Cristian Penilla, and Teal Bunbury. With three games remaining, Penilla and Bunbury are deadlocked atop the Revolution's golden boot race with 11 goals apiece; Penilla holds the advantage with six assists on the season to Bunbury's four.

Following Saturday's match, the Revolution will return to action on Thursday, Oct. 18 when the club travels west for its final away test of the season at Real Salt Lake. The match will kick off at 9:00 p.m. ET on NBC Sports Boston, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and 1260 AM Nossa Radio.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against Orlando City. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday's match.

- New England remaining unbeaten all-time against Orlando at home. The Revs own a 2-0-1 record against the Lions in Foxborough since they joined MLS as an expansion team in 2015.
- **F Teal Bunbury** and **F Cristian Penilla** breaking their deadlock atop the club's golden boot race, where they are tied with 11 goals apiece. Only one Revs player in the last four seasons has scored at least 12 goals (Kei Kamara -- 12 in 2017).
- **M Diego Fagundez** (48 goals) scoring twice to become the youngest MLS player to record 50 career regular season goals, per the Elias Sports Bureau.
- **GK Brad Knighton** continuing to rank among the league leaders in saves since Sept. 1, where he is tied for first with 26 stops.
- There are several notable connections between the Revolution and Orlando City SC:
 - Revolution forward **Teal Bunbury** (2012-13) and defender **Jalil Anibaba** (2015) were teammates with Orlando City SC forward **Dom Dwyer** on Sporting Kansas City.
 - Revolution midfielder **Mark Segbers** and Orlando City forward **Chris Mueller** were teammates at the University of Wisconsin from 2014-17.
 - Revolution Head Coach **Brad Friedel** coached Orlando City midfielder **Pierre Da Silva** on the U.S. Under-19 Men's National Team.
