## **GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. New York Red Bulls**

*Revolution to play Red Bulls in midweek Eastern Conference clash*

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution are back home for a midweek match against the New York Red Bulls on Wednesday, July 5 at Gillette Stadium. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on CSN New England with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama on the call. Saturday's match airs locally on the radio at 98.5 The Sports Hub and on WMVX 1570 AM Nossa Radio in Portuguese. Following the match, fans will be treated to a postgame fireworks show to celebrate Independence Day.

Wednesday's contest will be the second and final MLS meeting between New England and New York this season. In the most recent matchup between the two teams, the Revs fell to New York, 2-1, on May 27 at Red Bull Arena. The Revs have had recent success against the Red Bulls, posting a 4-2-0 record, including a 3-0-0 mark at home, dating back to 2015.

The Revolution and Red Bulls will meet again the following week in the 2017 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup. New England will host the quarterfinal match at Harvard University's Jordan Field on Thursday, July 13 at 7:30 p.m. ET. The Revs will return to MLS action on July 22, when the club hosts the LA Galaxy (NBC Boston, CSN New England).

### **WHAT TO WATCH FOR**

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Wednesday's match against the New York Red Bulls. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Wednesday's match.

- The **Revolution** have had success this season in midweek matches. New England will attempt to remain unbeaten across all competitions in Wednesday games in 2017, with a 2-0-2 record including two U.S. Open Cup victories.
- Midfielder **Lee Nguyen** is having an All-Star caliber season with 13 combined goals and assists. He is currently one of seven MLS players to record at least six goals and six assists this season. The midfielder recorded either a goal or an assist in seven of eight matches from April 22 through June 3 for the Revolution.
- Defender **Chris Tierney** is closing in on a pair of accomplishments. Should Tierney record two assists, he will become the third player in club history to cross the 40-assist threshold. In addition, if the defender takes four corner kicks, he will pass Steve Ralston for the all-time club record, which currently stands at 456 career corners.
- There are a number of connections between New England and New York including:
  - Revolution forwards **Teal Bunbury** and **Kei Kamara** both played alongside Red Bulls defender Aurélien Collin with Sporting Kansas City from 2011-13.
  - Revolution forward **Juan Agudelo** was the second Homegrown Player signing in New York Red Bulls history. Agudelo, who signed with the first team in 2010 at age 17, made 33 appearances in two-plus seasons with the Red Bulls, registering six goals and two assists.
  - Revolution assistant coach **Tom Soehn**, Red Bulls head coach Jesse Marsch, and Red Bulls assistant coach Chris Armas were teammates on the Chicago Fire from 1998-2000. The trio played integral roles in helping Chicago become the first and only expansion team to win MLS Cup in 1998.
