GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. New York Red Bulls

*Revolution host 2017 U.S. Open Cup Quarterfinal Thursday at Harvard's Jordan Field

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution will resume play in the 2017 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup in a Quarterfinal match against the New York Red Bulls on Thursday at Harvard University's Jordan Field in Boston, Mass. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be streamed on USsoccer.com and RevolutionSoccer.net with Brad Feldman and Paul Mariner on the call.

The 2017 U.S. Open Cup marks New England's 18th appearance in the tournament. Last year, the Revs made their third appearance in the U.S. Open Cup Final, falling to FC Dallas, 4-2, on Sept. 13, 2016. The club has accrued a 20-14-5 record in 39 total games in the competition, with a 13-4-3 mark in home games. New England won the U.S. Open Cup in 2007 when current head coach and then-defender Jay Heaps started three games en route to the championship.

Wednesday's match will be the fourth all-time Open Cup meeting between New England and New York dating back to the two sides' initial matchup in the Quarterfinals of the 2003 U.S. Open Cup. The Revs are 1-2-0 in the tournament against New York and hold a 1-0-0 mark in home matches. The Revs' most recent Open Cup match against the Red Bulls was on June 12, 2013, a 4-2 victory in the Fourth Round at Jordan Field.

Following Thursday's Open Cup match, New England will return to MLS play at Gillette Stadium on Saturday, July 22 against the LA Galaxy. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be broadcast over the air to Boston residents on NBC Boston, and will also be available live to non-residents on CSN New England. Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama will have the call on television and on the radio at 98.5 The Sports Hub. The match is also available on the radio in Portuguese on WMXV 1570 AM Nossa Radio USA.
