GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution vs. LA Galaxy

Revolution to play LA Galaxy in return to MLS play

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution are back home for a match against the LA Galaxy on Saturday, July 21 at Gillette Stadium. The match kicks off at 7:30 p.m. ET and will be televised locally on both NBC Boston and CSN New England with Brad Feldman, Paul Mariner, and Naoko Funayama on the call. Saturday's match airs locally on the radio at 98.5 The Sports Hub and on WMVX 1570 AM Nossa Radio in Portuguese.

Saturday's contest will be the first and only MLS meeting between New England and LA this season. In the most recent matchup between the two teams, the Revs fell to LA, 4-2, on May 8, 2016 at StubHub Center.

Following Saturday's match, the Revolution will be back in action for a matchup against the Philadelphia Union at Gillette Stadium at 7:30 p.m. ET on Saturday, July 29.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against the LA Galaxy. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday's match.

- The **Revolution** will look to improve on the club's current winning record against Western Conference opposition, which currently stands at 3-2-3 and includes a 3-0-1 mark in matches played at Gillette Stadium.

- Midfielder **Diego Fagundez** and **Lee Nguyen** will reach milestones should they start in Saturday's match. Fagundez could make his 125th career MLS/Revolution start, while Nguyen could make his 175th career MLS/Revolution start.
- Midfielder **Diego Fagundez** is one assist away (36G/29A) from becoming the fifth player in club history to register at least 30 goals and 30 assists as a Revolution player. **Lee Nguyen** (47G/41A), Steve Ralston (42G/73A), Joe-Max Moore (41G/35A), and Shalrie Joseph (37G/34A) are the others to accomplish the feat.
- Defender **Chris Tierney** is closing in on a pair of accomplishments. Should Tierney record two assists, he will become the third player in club history to cross the 40-assist threshold. In addition, if the defender takes four corner kicks, he will pass Steve Ralston for the all-time club record, which currently stands at 456 career corners.
- There are a number of connections between New England and New York including:
 - Revolution forward **Juan Agudelo** and midfielder **Kelyn Rowe** played alongside Galaxy forward Gyasi Zardes for the U.S. Men's National Team during the 2017 CONCACAF Gold Cup Group Stage.
 - Revolution defender **Benjamin Angoua** (EA Guingamp) and LA Galaxy midfielder Romain Alessandrini (Stade Rennais FC, Marseille) played against each other multiple times in France's Ligue 1.
 - Revolution midfielder **Kelyn Rowe** and LA Galaxy goalkeeper Brian Rowe were teammates at UCLA from 2010-11.
 - Revolution forward **Juan Agudelo** and LA Galaxy General Manager and Vice President of Soccer Operations Pete Vagenas were teammates on Chivas USA in 2013.
 - LA Galaxy midfielder Jermaine Jones played for New England from 2014-15. He made 34 combined regular and postseason appearances for the Revolution and helped lead the club to an MLS Cup appearance in 2014.
