GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution at Atlanta United FC

Revolution begin two-game road swing with first ever match vs. Atlanta

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (10-12-5, 35 pts.) will play the first of two away matches this week against Atlanta United FC on Wednesday, Sept. 13. The match at Mercedes-Benz Stadium kicks off at 7:00 p.m. ET on CSN New England, where Brad Feldman and Paul Mariner will have the call. Fans may also listen locally on the radio at 98.5 The Sports Hub and on WMVX 1570 AM Nossa Radio in Portuguese.

Wednesday's meeting will be the Revolution's first against 2017 expansion side Atlanta United FC, which has recorded an 11-8-6 record (39 pts.) in its debut campaign. New England will face Atlanta for a second time on Saturday, Sept. 30 at Gillette Stadium in the penultimate home contest of the regular season. The two clubs enter Wednesday's meeting fighting for playoff position in the Eastern Conference, as Atlanta currently holds the sixth spot with a four-point advantage on the Revs.

Following Wednesday's match, New England will continue on to Missouri for a meeting with Sporting Kansas City on Saturday, Sept. 16. The contest will be the Revolution's last of the season with Western Conference opposition, against which New England owns a 5-2-3 record in 2017. The match will be broadcast locally on CSN New England, 98.5 The Sports Hub, and WMXV 1570 AM Nossa Radio

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against Atlanta United FC. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Wednesday's match.

- The **Revs** are seeking to record a fourth straight shutout at home, which would match the second longest streak in club history. New England last had a four-game home shutout streak from March 22 - May 11, 2014. The club record for consecutive home shutouts is five games (April 9 – May 28, 2005).
- New England has not lost at home in the month of September since Sept. 8, 2013 vs. Montreal. The Revs are 9-0-2 at home in September during that four-year stretch.
- Midfielder **Lee Nguyen** will seek to keep pace with Toronto FC's Victor Vazquez in assists. Both Nguyen and Vazquez currently lead MLS with 14 helpers on the season. Nguyen (22) trails only New York City's David Villa (28) and Portland's Diego Valeri (25) in combined goals and assists this season.
- With his next goal, forward **Kei Kamara** will reach the single-season mark of 12 goals for the second time in his career (2015). He currently leads the Revolution with 11 goals and is three tallies away from 100 career MLS regular season goals.
- Forward **Teal Bunbury**'s next goal will be his seventh goal since the beginning of July. His six goals since the turn of July are the third most in MLS during that span.
- There is a pair of connections between the Revolution and the Impact:
 - Revolution midfielder **Gershon Koffie** and Impact forward **Dominic Oduro** are both natives of Accra, Ghana.
 - Oduro was also a teammate of Revolution forward **Kei Kamara** in Houston in 2009.
