GAME PREVIEW: New England Revolution at Sporting Kansas City

Revolution conclude two-match road trip at Children's Mercy Park

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. – The New England Revolution (10-13-5, 35 pts.) will close out its two-match road trip against Sporting Kansas City on Saturday, Sept. 16. The match at Children's Mercy Park kicks off at 8:30 p.m. ET on CSN New England, where Brad Feldman and Paul Mariner will have the call. Fans may also listen locally on the radio at 98.5 The Sports Hub and on WMVX 1570 AM Nossa Radio in Portuguese.

Saturday's meeting will be the Revolution's first and only match against Western Conference side Sporting Kansas City. New England has fared well against the opposite conference this season, posting a 5-2-3 record against Western Conference teams. New England has had recent success against Kansas City, winning four of five meetings since the start of the 2014 season. In the most recent meeting between the two clubs, the Revs defeated Sporting, 3-1, on October 1, 2016 at Gillette Stadium.

Following Saturday's match, New England will return to Foxborough to prepare for a meeting with Toronto FC at Gillette Stadium on Saturday, Sept. 23. The contest will be the Revolution's third and final matchup of the season with Eastern Conference leaders.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

Here are some relevant storylines ahead of Saturday's match against Sporting Kansas City. Click [HERE](#) to view the complete Revolution Game Notes for Saturday's match.

- Midfielder **Lee Nguyen** (49G/48A) is closing in on becoming the 19th player in MLS history, and the first Revolution player, to record 50 goals and 50 assists in a career.

- With his next goal, forward **Kei Kamara** will reach the single-season mark of 12 goals for the second time in his career (2015). He currently leads the Revolution with 11 goals and is three tallies away from 100 career MLS regular season goals.
- Forward **Teal Bunbury**'s next goal will be his seventh goal since the beginning of July. His six goals since the turn of July are tied for seventh most in MLS during that span.
- There are a number of connections between the Revolution and Sporting Kansas City including:
 - Three Revolution forwards—**Kei Kamara**, **Teal Bunbury**, and **Krisztián Németh**—previously played for the Kansas City Wizards/Sporting Kansas City.
 - **Kei Kamara** played for Kansas City from 2009–2013. He scored 38 goals in 113 regular season appearances for the club and won its Golden Boot Award twice (2010, 2012).
 - **Teal Bunbury** was selected by Kansas City with the fourth pick in the 2010 MLS SuperDraft. He played four seasons for the Wizards/SKC from 2010–2013, registering 19 goals and seven assists in 89 regular season appearances. His father, Alex Bunbury, also played for the Wizards from 1999–2000.
 - **Krisztián Németh** played one season for Sporting Kansas City in 2015. He submitted 10 goals, including the 2015 AT&T Goal of the Year, and six assists in 28 regular season appearances.
 - Sporting Kansas City midfielder **Benny Feilhaber** began his MLS career with the Revolution. He played in New England from 2011–2012, recording five goals and nine assists in 52 appearances.
 - Sporting Kansas City defender **Seth Sinovic** was selected by the Revolution in the second round of the 2010 MLS SuperDraft. He made 20 appearances, including 18 starts, in his lone campaign with New England.
