## WHAT TO WATCH FOR VS. CHICAGO FIRE FC II

- Revolution II hold a seven match unbeaten streak, including winning five of their last six contests. The seven-match unbeaten run ties the second-longest undefeated stretch in club history.
- New England's defense has conceded 11 goals this season, the fewest in the Eastern Conference and tied for third-fewest across the league. During the seven-match unbeaten streak, Revolution II recorded four of their six total shutouts this season. Their six clean sheets are tied for third in MLS NEXT Pro.
- Revolution II have been in strong form at home this season, earning their fifth win at Beirne Stadium on Sunday against Red Bulls New York II. New England's five home wins is tied for second in MLS NEXT Pro.
- **F/W Myles Morgan** continued to spark the attack, scoring his team-leading fifth goal of the season. The Canada native leads the team with 32 shots, including 13 on target.
- **M Javaun Mussenden** found the back of the net for the first time this season, marking the second professional goal of his career. The 18-year-old Homegrown player, who returned from international duty last week, has contributed to three goals this campaign, adding two assists earlier in the season.
- **D Damario McIntosh** is tied for the team lead in assists, tallying his third helper of the season against Red Bulls New York II. The Homegrown defender, who also returned from international duty last week, has started nine of his 11 appearances this season and has contributed to four goals across the campaign.

## MATCH PREVIEW VS. CHICAGO FIRE FC II

Revolution II enters Sunday's contest amid one of the strongest stretches in club history, carrying a seven-match unbeaten run (5-0-2). New England's undefeated streak includes five wins in its last six matches. In New England's most recent outing on Sunday, Revolution II returned to Beirne Stadium and claimed a 2-1 victory over Red Bulls New York II. The result marked New England's fifth home win of the season, tied for the second-most in MLS NEXT Pro.

New England's success has been anchored by a defensive unit that remains one of the best in the conference. Revolution II have conceded only 11 goals this season, the fewest in the Eastern Conference and tied for third-fewest across the league. During its current seven-game unbeaten run, New England has recorded four of its six clean sheets on the year, tied for third in MLS NEXT Pro. The backline has also limited opponents to just 45 shots, the fewest shots attempts conceded in the league.

Revolution II's defensive unit against Red Bulls II featured full 90-minute performances from **Jared Smith**, **Gabe Dahlin**, **Jake Shannon**, and **Damario McIntosh**. McIntosh, who returned from international duty with Jamaica's Under-20 National Team last week, recorded his third assist of the season- tied for the team lead. In goal, Academy graduate **Max Weinstein** made his second consecutive start and helped guide Revolution II to their 2-1 win over Red Bull by recording two key second-half saves.

Forward/winger **Myles Morgan** continued to power the New England attack on Sunday, scoring the opening goal against Red Bulls II. The Canadian striker, who celebrated his 21st birthday this week, tallied his team-leading fifth goal of the season and his sixth goal contribution on Sunday. In his debut season with Revolution II, Morgan has made nine starts in 13 appearances and also leads the team with 32 total shots, including 13 on target.

Homegrown midfielder **Javaun Mussenden** opened his 2026 account on Sunday, netting the game-winning goal just before halftime. Mussenden, who also returned from international duty with the United States U-19 National Team last week, has been a consistent presence in New England's midfield this season, starting in 11 contests. The goal marked the second of his career and his third total goal contribution this season.

New England takes on Chicago Fire FC II for the first time this season and enters the matchup leading the all-time MLS NEXT Pro regular-season series, 3-2-5. Revolution II is unbeaten at home against Chicago in league play and will look to claim their fifth consecutive league result against Sunday's visitors. Chicago is led by Darris Hye and Dean Boltz, who have scored three goals each, while Owen Pratt has anchored the team in goal with 23 saves.

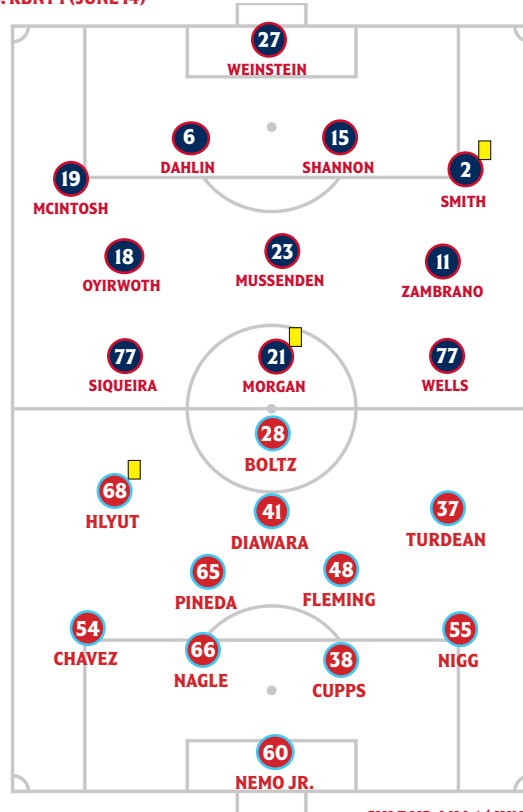

**TEAM NOTES**
**MORGAN EMERGES AS LEADING SCORER FOR NEW ENGLAND**

Through New England's first 13 matches, forward/winger **Myles Morgan** has rapidly become the breakout attacking force of Revolution II's 2026 campaign. The 21-year-old newcomer is leading the squad with five goals and six goal contributions in his debut season.



From the moment he arrived, Morgan fit seamlessly into Revolution II head coach **Pablo Moreira's** system, building quick chemistry with his teammates and injecting pace into the front line. His impact was immediate, as he opened Revolution II's 2026 scoring account on March 1, burying a composed finish against Atlanta United 2 to mark his first goal for the club.

Morgan's second tally came on the road at Columbus Crew 2 on April 18, where he headed home New England's lone goal of the match. That strike sparked a run of consistency, as the young Canadian began stamping his name on the scoresheet with growing regularity.

He converted a crucial penalty in New England's win over New York City FC II on May 10, leveling the match at 1-1. Just three days later at Philadelphia Union II, Morgan shifted from scorer to creator, delivering the game-winning assist on defender **Jake Shannon's** 86th-minute finish.

The momentum carried into the May 22 clash at Crown Legacy FC. Driving the ball upfield, Morgan helped initiate the attacking sequence before midfielder **Carlos Zambrano** lofted a clever chip into the box — setting up the 20-year-old to slot home yet another composed finish. The effort was awarded MLS NEXT Pro Goal of Matchweek 12, marking the second time this season a New England player has earned the honor.

In Revolution II's latest outing on June 14 against Red Bulls New York II, Morgan connected with Homegrown defender **Damario McIntosh** on a give-and-go inside the box, before cutting across the defender and slotting a left-footed finish past a diving Red Bull II goalkeeper.

Before joining Revolution II, Morgan spent time with Canadian Premier League and MLS NEXT Pro clubs. Most recently, Morgan logged seven goals and three assists over 26 appearances for Valour FC. Morgan concluded the 2025 season as the team's leading scorer, highlighted by a hat trick in a 5-2 victory over Vancouver FC on September 5. Morgan also featured in two Canadian Championship matches.

For Morgan, the surge in production is simple. "I'm just doing my job," he said. "[Pablo Moreira] is relying on me to score goals. That's my job as a striker - to score goals."

With his confidence rising and his influence growing each week, Morgan has quickly become one of Revolution II's most exciting young attacking threats and adds a dangerous layer to New England's attacking unit.

**REVOLUTION RESERVE TEAM SCRIMMAGES AGAINST FRANCE NATIONAL TEAM AT BENTLEY UNIVERSITY**

New England Revolution reserve players, consisting of current Revolution Pro Pathway players and alumni, played a friendly scrimmage against the France National Team at their Bentley University base camp on Wednesday, June 17.

The French Football Federation invited the Revolution to their training camp in Waltham for a training match as the FIFA World Cup powerhouses stay sharp between group stage matches. The Revolution squad was comprised of current Revolution II players, who compete in MLS NEXT Pro, current Revolution Academy players, and Revolution Academy alumni who now play collegiate soccer at a variety of NCAA Division I programs.

"Playing against the French team and [playing against] the team you watch growing up, and just the best players in the world, obviously playing in the world cup, is just a great experience and I am happy to be here," said Logan Azar, a Revolution Academy product.


**REVOLUTION HOMETOWN DEFENDER DAMARIO MCINTOSH CALLED UP TO JAMAICA UNDER-20 NATIONAL TEAM**

New England Revolution defender **Damario McIntosh** earned his first international call-up, joining the Jamaica Under-20 National Team for its training camp in Lauderhill, Florida. In preparation for this summer's Concacaf Under-20 Championship, the *Reggae Boyz* recorded a 9-0 win over Haiti's Under-20s on June 6, then fell 4-1 in a penalty shootout to United Premier Soccer League side Miami United FC after a 1-1 draw in regulation on June 7.

Born in Westmoreland, Jamaica, McIntosh entered the Revolution Academy's residency program in 2023 and became the club's 14th Homegrown Player signing in January 2025. With Revolution II, the 18-year-old right back has suited up for 60 MLS NEXT Pro appearances, including 51 starts, recording one goal and three assists. Earlier this month, McIntosh netted his first professional goal, a game winner, in a 3-2 victory over New York City FC II on May 10.

A 2024 MLS NEXT All Star, McIntosh earned his first team debut in the 2026 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup, registering an assist in New England's Round of 32 match against Rhode Island FC on April 14. In the Round of 16, McIntosh logged an 83-minute shift against Orlando City SC on April 29. On May 23, the Homegrown defender featured on the Revolution's MLS matchday roster for the first time at Charlotte FC.

**TEAM NOTES**
**REVOLUTION HOMEGROWN PRODUCTS CALLED INTO U.S. YOUTH NATIONAL TEAMS**

New England Revolution midfielder **Cristiano Oliveira** and Revolution II midfielder **Javaun Mussenden**, both graduates of the Revolution Academy, were called into the United States Under-18 and Under-19 Men's Youth National Teams, respectively, for training camps during the June international window.

Oliveira, 18, traveled to Spain with the U.S. Under-18s from June 1-9. While overseas, the team played in two friendly matches, falling 2-0 to Sweden on June 5 before posting a 2-0 win over Qatar on June 8. The Revolution Homegrown Player from Somerville, Mass. earned his second call-up to the U-18 squad, recently playing in two matches during the March window.

In Revolution's match at Charlotte FC on May 23, Oliveira logged his Major League Soccer debut as a substitute. Oliveira has made four additional appearances for the Revolution first team in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup, with one game-winning goal. The Brazilian American has collected an additional seven starts with Revolution II in MLS NEXT Pro, where he leads the developmental team with three assists this season. Oliveira owns five goals and four assists over 42 career appearances with Revolution II.

The local product has also represented the United States at the U-15, U-16, and U-17 levels, including three appearances for the U.S. Under-17 side at the 2025 Concacaf Under-17 Championship. Oliveira scored his first international goal during the tournament in a 7-0 win over St. Kitts & Nevis. Oliveira has also participated in training camps with the United States Under-15 and Under-16 squads.

Mussenden, also 18, joined the Under-19 national team for its training camp in Fayetteville, Ga. from June 1-10. The selection marks the second international call-up for the 2024-25 Revolution Academy Player of the Year. In a scrimmage, the U.S. Under-19s posted a 5-2 win in an international friendly against Japan on June 9 at the U.S. Soccer National Training Center.

Prior to the 2026 season, Mussenden became the 15th player to sign a professional contract with Revolution II directly from the club's academy ranks. Across parts of two seasons with Revolution II, Mussenden has recorded two goals and four assists in 39 MLS NEXT Pro appearances, including 27 starts. A member of the Revolution Academy's residency program since 2023, Mussenden has featured at both the Under-17 and Under-18 levels for New England. The Dallas, Ga. native tallied one goal and one assist with New England's Under-18 squad during the 2025-26 MLS NEXT fall campaign.

**PABLO MOREIRA NAMED MLS NEXT PRO COACH OF MAY**

New England Revolution II head coach **Pablo Moreira** was named MLS NEXT Pro Head Coach of the Month for May after the team's standout performance.

Moreira, in his first season as a head coach, guided Revolution II to an unbeaten run in May, with New England earning points in every match, including three wins and a shootout victory. The results pushed Revolution II closer to the top of the Eastern Conference, as the team finished the month with 22 points.

"It's a testament to the work our club, players, and staff put in day in and day out," said Moreira.

"It's an honor I humbly accept because of the level of coaches in the league, and ultimately my peers are the ones who vote on this award, and many of them were just as deserving."

**DEFENSE DEFINES REVOLUTION II**

Every successful team has an identity. For New England, that identity starts at the back. Anchored by a defensive unit that ranks among the league leaders in several statistical categories, Revolution II has built their early-season success on organization, consistency, and a commitment to keeping opponents off the scoresheet.

Revolution II, currently sitting at fourth place in the Eastern Conference with 28 points, have limited opponents to just 11 goals this season, ranking third in MLS NEXT Pro in fewest goals conceded. Much of that success has come from limiting opponents' opportunities, as Revolution II lead the league for the fewest shots allowed with 45.

Revolution II's defensive mindset has fueled a seven-match unbeaten streak, tying the second-longest undefeated run in club history. Emerging as two of the leaders of the backline during the successful stretch are center backs **Jake Shannon** and **Gabe Dahlin**. In the last seven matches, Shannon and Dahlin have each logged six consecutive 90-minute performances and helped guide the team to four shutouts during that span.

"I think it's not only the defenders. We defend as a team," Dahlin said about the success of the backline. "It all starts with the press, and when we press good, we don't really have to do much."

The pair has not only been integral defensively but has also contributed to the attack. Over the past seven games, Dahlin has distributed three game-winning assists, while Shannon has found the back of the net twice.

"We just try to be in the right spots at the right time," said Shannon. "I feel like Gabe and I have made a good partnership where we are able to contribute to the team in the best way that we can."

Alongside Shannon and Dahlin, defenders **Damarion McIntosh** and **Jared Smith** have become mainstays on the backline in recent weeks. McIntosh, an 18-year-old Homegrown Player, has contributed on four goals this season, tallying three assists and a game-winning goal. Smith, who joined Revolution II in March, has worked his way into a starting role, earning four starts in his last five appearances — all during the club's current seven-match unbeaten run.

Another key component of New England's defensive excellence has come between the posts. Goalkeepers **Donovan Parisian**, **J.D. Gunn**, and **Max Weinstein** have all logged minutes this season, each playing a role in the club's six clean sheets, tied for the third-most in MLS NEXT Pro.

That success has come from multiple sources. Parisian, the club's 2025 first-round MLS SuperDraft selection, owns three shutouts this season, while Gunn, a Panama international, has added two. New England has also turned to Weinstein, a 22-year-old Academy graduate, who made two saves in his season debut to help secure the club's sixth clean sheet of the campaign at FC Cincinnati 2 on June 7.

"You hear a constant voice behind you, and we just have 100 percent trust in whoever is behind us and that helps us going forward as a team," said Shannon.

In a sport often defined by goals, Revolution II have found strength in preventing them. New England's defensive mindset has become a cornerstone of its identity, reinforcing a belief shared throughout the club - good teams can score goals, but great teams are built on defense.

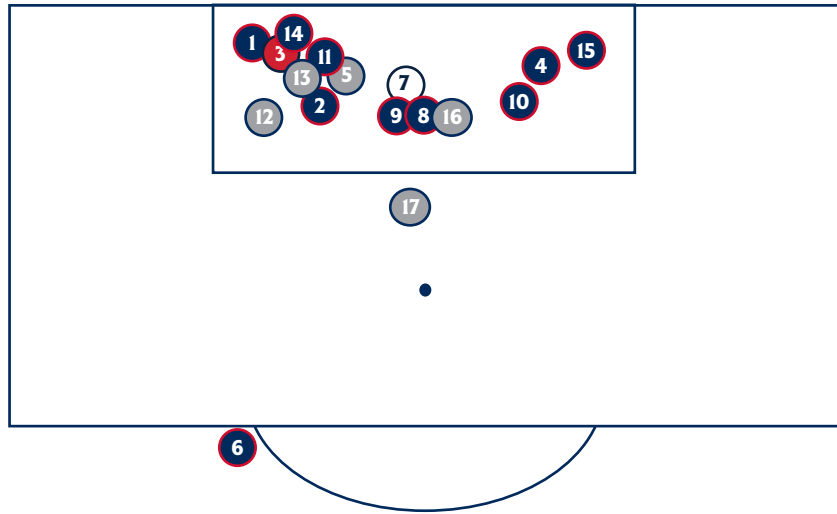

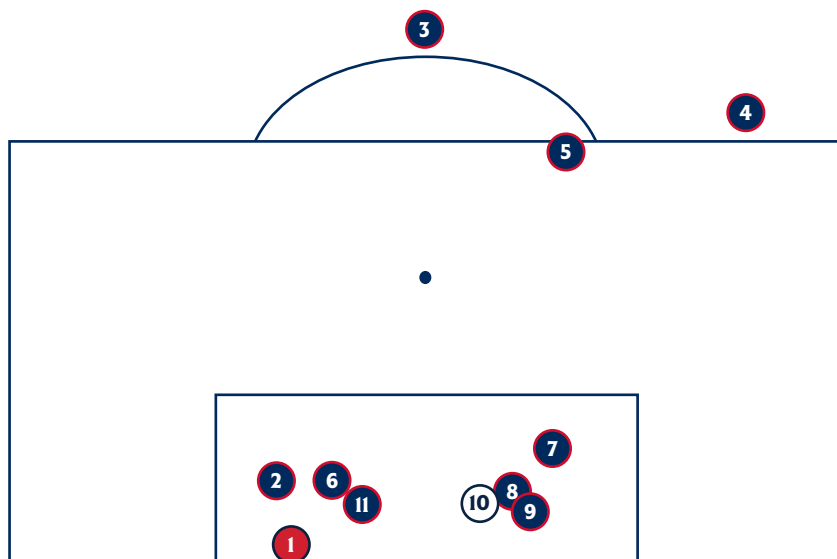

Pablo Moreira is in his first season as Head Coach of New England Revolution II, joining the developmental side after two seasons on the Revolution's first-team staff, including a four-game spell as interim head coach in 2025, and 11 campaigns as an assistant coach in Major League Soccer. Moreira is a two-time MLS Cup champion with over 400 matches coached in his career. During his tenure in MLS, Moreira has coached an MLS League MVP, MLS Cup MVP, Newcomer of the Year, Goalkeeper of the Year, seven MLS Best XI selections, and nine MLS All-Star Selections en route to 155 career wins as an assistant.

Prior to joining the Revolution, Moreira served as an Assistant Coach for the Columbus Crew from 2019-22. Moreira helped guide the Crew to the 2020 MLS Cup title, becoming the youngest assistant coach in league history to win multiple MLS Cups — the first to do so with clubs in both conferences. The next year, he helped lead Columbus to the 2021 Campeones Cup, the club's first international trophy, beating Liga MX champions Cruz Azul.

Moreira, 41, entered the professional ranks as an Assistant Coach for the Portland Timbers from 2013-17. Moreira's first season with the Timbers included a 23-point improvement and a 43-point goal-differential improvement from the previous season, securing a first-place finish in the Western Conference and the club's first postseason berth. During his tenure, Moreira helped lead Portland to its first MLS Cup championship in 2015, as well as Concacaf Champions League appearances in 2014 and 2016, Western Conference regular season first-place finishes in 2013 and 2017, and a Cascadia Cup in 2017.

At the collegiate level, Moreira served as an Assistant Coach / Video Analyst at the University of Akron from 2010-2012. The Zips compiled a 55-6-9 record during his three seasons, while Moreira helped assemble the nation's No. 2 recruiting class in each of his first three years, producing 14 professionals into the MLS ranks during that span. In 2011, Akron set an MLS record for most first-round selections from a single school, landing five of the first eight picks in the MLS SuperDraft. Akron won the National Championship in 2010 in addition to three consecutive Mid-American Conference regular-season titles (2010-12), and two MAC Tournament championships (2010, 2012).

Moreira played as a forward for the Akron Zips from 2003-07. He was on the first Mid-American Conference team to be ranked No. 1 in the nation in any sport in 2005. Moreira earned All-Mid-American Conference honors in 2006 and 2007, in addition to winning three MAC regular season (2005, 2006, 2007) and Conference Tournament championships (2004, 2005, 2007).

Born in Montevideo, Uruguay, Moreira comes from a distinguished soccer lineage as he is the son of former Uruguayan International Jose "Chico" Moreira, who in 1980 with club side Nacional, captured the South American Treble winning the Club World Cup, Copa Libertadores, and Uruguayan Primera Division League Titles, in addition to winning the 1980 Mundialito (Copa de Oro de Campeones Mundiales) with the Uruguay National Team.

Michael Milazzo is entering his second season as an Assistant Coach with New England Revolution II and his fourth season with the club. His coaching career also includes a tenure with Columbus Crew SC, where he served as both Academy Director and Head Coach of the Under-18 team from 2015-16. Prior to Columbus, Milazzo was Assistant Coach of the Richmond Kickers of the USL. In Richmond, Milazzo held a dual role of serving as the Academy Manager of Richmond United Academy in 2014, while overseeing the Under-18, Under-16, and Under-14 teams competing in the nationally recognized U.S. Soccer Development Academy, for the Richmond Strikers Academy program in 2013.

A native of Cary, N.C., Milazzo began his coaching career in 1997 as an Assistant Coach at University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, his alma mater. From 1999 to 2012, Milazzo took on various roles with the Capital Area Soccer League's Chelsea FC Academy, including Academy Director, General Manager, and Head Coach of several youth teams. Milazzo is certified with his USSF "A" Senior coaching license and his UEFA "B" coaching license with the Scottish Football Federation.

**BRAD KNIGHTON**
**ASSISTANT COACH/GOALKEEPER COACH**


Brad Knighton is entering his second season as the Assistant Coach/Goalkeeper Coach for Revolution II, the New England Revolution's developmental side which began play in 2020. Coaching alongside Michael Milazzo in 2025, Knighton also helped guide Revolution II to their second postseason appearance in team history. Knighton spent the 2023-24 seasons as a Head Coach for the Revolution Academy, competing in MLS NEXT.

In Knighton's first season with the Revolution Academy, he led the Under-19s to the MLS NEXT Cup Championship, securing New England's second consecutive national title. The Under-19s finished 18-3-5 overall in 2022-23, including 3-0-2 in the postseason. After switching to the Under-15s level in 2024, Knighton stayed on staff to help guide the Academy to a 8-1-4 record in MLS NEXT Flex action.

Prior to his coaching days, the Hickory, N.C. native began his playing career with New England in 2007 as an undrafted free agent. He went on to set a club record for the most MLS seasons in a Revolution uniform (12), and registered a 33-29-20 mark in his career, including 21 wins for the Revolution. During his tenure, Knighton helped New England win the 2021 Supporters' Shield, and started four games en route to the 2016 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup Final.

Knighton, 41, retired after the 2022 MLS season and ranks fourth in Revolution history in goals against average (1.70), save percentage (66.9), and winning percentage (.509) among qualifying goalkeepers. In U.S. Open Cup play, he holds the club's all-time record in games played in goal (13), games started in goal (13), and minutes played in goal (1,260). Outside of New England, Knighton played for the Philadelphia Union during their inaugural season in 2010, and helped lead Vancouver Whitecaps FC to its first appearance in the MLS Cup Playoffs in 2012.

Beyond his on-field achievements, the 2022 Revolution Humanitarian of the Year continues to dedicate his time to serving the New England community alongside his family. On November 3, 2025, the Knighton family marked the two-year anniversary of the Olivia Knighton Foundation. Brad, his wife, Britney, and their sons Owen and Brooks launched the foundation in 2023 on the birthday of their late daughter, Olivia, and has since donated over \$100,000 through scholarships, soccer programs, animal research, and more.
