Revolution Unified Team Hosts Toronto FC Unified Team at Gillette Stadium on Wednesday Night

Special Olympics Massachusetts athletes and Unified partners host international opponent after Revolution's first game back following the FIFA World Cup™

WHAT:

Media are invited to join **Special Olympics Massachusetts (SOMA)** and the **New England Revolution** on **Wednesday, July 22** following the final whistle of the Revolution's MLS match (approx. 9:45 p.m. ET). At **10:00 p.m. ET**, the **Revolution Unified Soccer Team** will take on the **Toronto FC Unified team** on the Gillette Stadium pitch in the opening match of this year's Play Unified season. New England will play a home-and-away series against the Canadian side, with the Revolution Unified team traveling north of the border on August 15.

Prior to the match, the SOMA athletes will sign autographs in the Revolution Fan Zone (5:00-6:00 p.m. ET), before watching the MLS game from a suite. Warmups for the Unified matchup will begin at approximately 9:45 p.m., followed by the performance of the National Anthem. After the match, media are invited to capture the scarfing ceremony at midfield and a joint photo opportunity with both Unified teams.

Now in its 12th season, the Revolution's Special Olympics Unified Team is a core tenet of the club's "Soccer for All" platform, reinforcing that Major League Soccer is a welcoming environment for all players, fans, and partners regardless of disability, race, religion, national origin, gender identity, sexual orientation or socioeconomic status. The team is comprised of athletes both with and without intellectual disabilities, most from Massachusetts and one from Rhode Island, sending a important message about the power of inclusion. On **Tuesday, August 4th at 6:00 p.m.**, the Revolution will host their annual Bowl for a Goal presented by Arbella Insurance, a full-team fundraising event at Splitsville Luxury Lanes at Patriot Place. All proceeds from the bowling event will support Special Olympics Massachusetts. To date, Bowl for a Goal has raised over \$700,000 for Special Olympics' Play Unified programs, with 2026 already on track to set be a record year.

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About the New England Revolution

The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Through 30 MLS seasons, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. The Revolution also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles. The Revolution play their home matches at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. The club and its acclaimed pro pathway, including Revolution II (MLS NEXT Pro) and the Revolution Academy, are headquartered at the Revolution Training Center, which opened ahead of the 2020 season.
