PREVIEW: Revolution Travel to Toronto FC on Saturday Night

New England on the road for six of next seven matches

FOXBOROUGH, Mass. (August 14, 2026) – The New England Revolution (9-6-3, 30 pts.) travel to Canada this weekend for a matchup at Toronto FC on Saturday night at BMO Field. The 7:30 p.m. ET kickoff airs on [Apple TV](#) in English and Spanish. Listen to the Revolution's local radio calls on 98.5 The Sports Hub (English) and 1260 AM Nossa Radio USA (Portuguese).

New England, set to play six of its next seven games on the road, will lock horns with Toronto for the second time in three weeks, after the two sides battled to a 0-0 stalemate on July 22 at Gillette Stadium in the Revolution's return to play following the World Cup break. Goalkeeper **Matt Turner** collected his fourth clean sheet of the season in that draw, moving his career record against Toronto to 2-1-4 with a pair of shutouts. New England has taken points in each of its last three encounters with Toronto FC (1-0-2), including two clean sheets.

Last Saturday, New England fell to Houston Dynamo FC, 2-0, in what was just the second home loss in 11 games at Gillette Stadium this season. English winger **Jack Harrison**, signed on July 25 from Leeds United, made his Revolution debut with a 36-minute shift off the bench. In his first MLS appearance since 2017, the Designated Player attempted two shots and completed all four of his dribbles. Homegrown winger **Peyton Miller**, who recently surpassed 50 MLS appearances, matched his career high with two shots on target in Saturday's defeat. The outside back-turned-winger provides pace on the outside, having logged the second-highest top speed in MLS this year at just under 37 kilometers per hour.

Revolution captain **Carles Gil** has found the scoresheet in eight of his last 12 appearances, with seven goals and four assists during that span. He enters the weekend one goal or assist away from reaching 150 goal contributions in his MLS career, more than all but two other active players. Against Toronto, the Spaniard has logged four goals and two helpers in 12 career appearances. Gil has paired well with forward **Dor Torgeman**, who has raised his season total to four goals and four assists, with a team-high 41 shot attempts.

New England position in the table is due in large part to the team's defensive resilience, conceding fewer goals than all but four MLS clubs with 23 goals allowed in 18 matches. The center back tandem of **Mamadou Fofana** and **Ethan Kohler** has blossomed into a strong partnership, starting the last 11 consecutive games together. Kohler has been one of the league's best passers this season, ranking second with a 95.2 percent success rate (min. 800 minutes played). On the outside, **Will Sands** has started all 18 matches at left back, while **Matt Polster** has started the last four matches as a right back.

Toronto FC was idle last weekend after a 1-1 draw in their last outing on July 31 at New York City FC. American midfielder Djordje Mihailovic tallied the equalizer deep into first-half stoppage time, as goalkeeper Luka Gavran notched four saves. The Reds attack is spearheaded by Hungarian forward Dániel Sallói, who owns a team-leading four goals and five assists after coming over from Sporting

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About the New England Revolution

The New England Revolution, owned and operated by the Kraft family, began play in 1996 as one of the original founding clubs of Major League Soccer (MLS). Through 30 MLS seasons, the Revolution are five-time MLS Eastern Conference champions and claimed the 2021 Supporters' Shield after a record-setting campaign. New England also won the 2008 North American SuperLiga and 2007 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup titles. The Revolution play their home matches at Gillette Stadium in Foxborough, Mass. The club and its acclaimed pro pathway, including Revolution II (MLS NEXT Pro) and the Revolution Academy, are headquartered at the Revolution Training Center, which opened ahead of the 2020 season.

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
